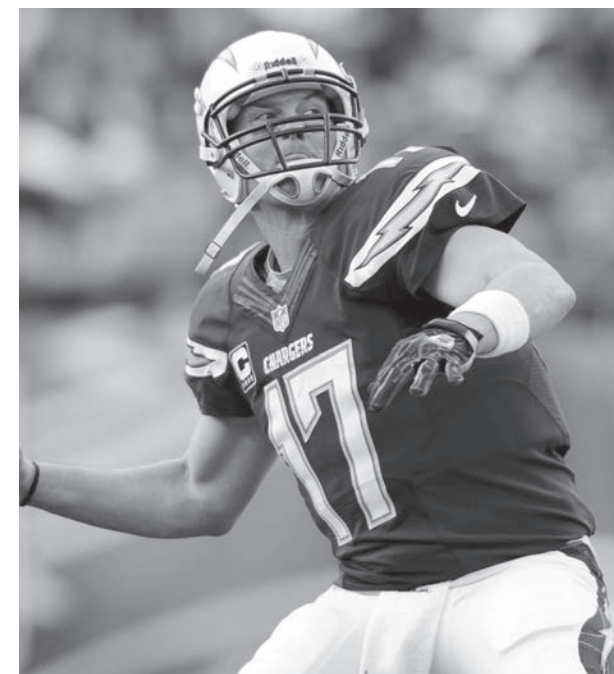

Holiday Programming Both Fresh and Familiar

It's already Christmastime on the major networks, and that comes with a few certainties. We can count on a sleigh full of familiar faces from holiday animation, while musical artists will be drawn into unlikely duets on variety specials and NBC will air "It's a Wonderful Life" a few times. Speaking of the classic 1947 family drama, its premise will undoubtedly be borrowed for the formulaic Christmas-themed episodes of far too many TV series - along with those of Charles Dickens' "A Christmas Carol" and O Henry's "The Gift of the Magi." But thankfully, there will be some fresh offerings among the traditional fare, with something to suit most everyone's sense of entertainment.

For instance, while there will be plenty of chances for the kiddies to rediscover Rudolph, Frosty, the Grinch and various incarnations of Santa Claus, a couple of new animated specials can be enjoyed by the whole family. Debuting Tuesday, Dec. 16, at 7 p.m. on NBC, "Elf: Buddy's Musical Christmas" stars four-time Emmy winner Jim Parsons ("The Big Bang Theory") as the voice of Buddy in an original hour-long stop-motion program based on

the popular film "Elf" and the hit Broadway show "Elf: The Musical." With nine new songs, the special features a voice cast including Mark Hamill, Ed Asner, Fred Armisen, Jay Leno, Matt Lauer, Gilbert Gottfried, Kate Micucci, Rachael MacFarlane, Max Charles and Steve Higgins.

And then on Thursday, Dec. 25, at 7 p.m., NBC encores the all-new "How Murray Saved Christmas," which tells how cranky deli owner Murray Weiner (voiced by Jerry Stiller, "The King of Queens") and Edison Elf (Sean Hayes, "Will & Grace") were forced to fill in for Santa Claus one Christmas. Based on the best selling children's book by four-time Emmy-winning writer Mike Reiss ("The Simpsons"), the one hour holiday musical co-stars Jason Alexander ("Seinfeld") and John Ratzenberger ("Cheers"), while featuring Dennis Haysbert ("24," the Allstate commercials) as the narrator.

For decidedly older viewers, CBS offers an encore presentation of last year's "I Love Lucy Christmas Special," Sunday at 7 p.m., in which stars Vivian Vance, Lucille Ball, Desi Arnaz and William Frawley appear in two back-to-back episodes of the classic comedy series, including the seldom-seen "Christmas Episode" and an all-new colorized version

of "Job Switching" (a.k.a. "Chocolate Factory"). Both episodes were tinted with a vintage look - a nod to the 1950s era in which the shows were filmed.

Also suitable for more mature tastes is the hour-long musical celebration of "Michael Bublé's Christmas in New York," airing Wednesday, Dec. 17, at 7 p.m. on NBC. Originating from Radio City Music Hall in New York City, Bublé's fourth annual NBC Christmas special features the multiple Grammy-winning singer and his band performing an "unplugged" series of songs requested by his social media followers, but that's secondary to his sharing the stage with Barbra Streisand, Miss Piggy, Ariana Grande and The Rockettes. "I could not be more excited to celebrate the Christmas holidays in New York with such a fantastic array of talented women," Bublé gushes.

Ariana Grande, by the way, will also perform on "The iHeartRadio Jingle Ball 2014," airing Thursday, Dec. 18, at 7 p.m. on The CW. The Madison Square Garden concert will also include Taylor Swift, Iggy Azalea, Maroon 5, Sam Smith, Pharrell Williams, OneRepublic, Meghan Trainor, 5 Seconds of Summer, Jessie J, Shawn Mendes and Nick Jonas. The music continues Tuesday, Dec. 23, at 7 p.m. as NBC airs

"One Direction: The TV Special," which a number of young fans will certainly consider a holiday gift in itself.

Friday, Dec. 19, at 7 p.m., NBC encores its annual presentation of "Christmas in Rockefeller Center," the star studded tree lighting extravaganza that also features Cyndi Lauper, Idina Menzel, LeAnn Rimes, Pentatonix, Sara Bareilles, Trisha Yearwood and the unlikely duo of Lady Gaga and Tony Bennett, all performing current hits and holiday classics.

For those who enjoy a bit of competition while needing a little inspiration for their holiday home decorations, "The Great Christmas Light Fight" returns for its second season on Monday, Dec. 8, at 7 p.m. on ABC. Lifetime Presents Miniseries Set in Biblical Times

When author Anita Diamant sat down to write "The Red Tent," which has been adapted into a four-hour miniseries airing Sunday at 8 p.m. on Lifetime, she wasn't thinking about writing a Bible story. She wanted to take an old story and write it from a point of view that had never been seen before.

"I didn't start by choosing this historical period," Diamant says. "I started with a story about a woman mentioned very briefly: Dinah. I thought there was a question posed by the text - a mystery even. What really happened to Jacob and Leah's daughter in the city of Shechem? Was she assaulted, as two of her brothers insisted? That's hard to see given that the man wanted to marry her and agrees to a very high bride price. But since Dinah doesn't say anything in the Bible, we really can't know what happened. So, in my novel, Dinah is the narrator. She has a voice. I set the book in about 1,500 B.C.E. and tried to describe the

period as best as I could, but there was very little information about the women of that time. I had to invent all sorts of things - food, clothing, work. I tried to make educated guesses based on the material I did find."

Once executive producer Paula Weinstein read the novel, she knew Dinah's (Rebecca Ferguson) tale had the makings of a great movie. "When I read the book, I was so moved by this powerful story," says Weinstein. "And what we all know to be true is that women have pretty much been written out of history and sidelined. The idea that there was a story of a girl in the early days of the Bible that was potentially such a great story really grabbed me. And it made me think of all the stories that were perhaps not told. You know about Leah (Minnie Driver) and Rachel (Morena Baccarin), but you don't really know what it was like to be a woman then."

In the miniseries, the red tent is where all of the women in the camp go and gather when they aren't feeling well, or to give birth. It's

a safe haven away from the men where they share their stories and their skills. Here, the writers depart somewhat from Diamant's novel, which stresses that the women were forcibly banished to the tent during their menstruation, a time when they were considered unclean. Such a practice was common among ancient cultures, with some tribes sending their women completely outside of their camps. Nevertheless, the women come to view their gathering inside the tent as a time of sisterhood and gender instruction for girls like Dinah, who learned much from her four mothers within this segregated environment.

Baccarin plays one of the four wives of Jacob (Iain Glen), a talented midwife who passes her skills down to Dinah. "I'd read the book years ago and I was excited when they asked me to be a part of this," Baccarin says. "She's described as like the pretty wife, young and impetuous. What I liked about the book is that it shows that the women were so much more and shares the different personalities. She is very impulsive, but whatever choices

she's making, they all come from her heart. These women are the heart of what happens in the camp.

"I've said many times to my friends that I had a red tent to go to. It seems like such a great wonderful place to be yourself. Women need a place to have some time away from their significant other. You need that place where you feel safe and you just want to be and have space. That's kind of what this is. Also, the traditions of storytelling get passed down. I loved how the bond between these women grows, and I

think it's important to have a community like that."

The midwifery scenes brought memories back for Baccarin. "I just had a baby a year ago, so that was all very clear and present in my mind," she continues. "I had a chance to chat with some midwives. But the great thing about this movie is that it isn't about the medicine or medical aspect of giving birth; it's about the emotional journey these women go on when giving birth and what all of that means. And it's about family. I felt like having had a kid gave me plenty of experience with that."

If the scenery feels authentic, it's meant to be. The miniseries was shot in Morocco. "It was incredibly hot," Baccarin laughs, "and it was incredibly dusty. It was tough. I have to say, battling the elements was not my favorite part of being there. It was terrible, and you'll see we're squinting throughout the movie because it was so bright. But I loved the place. The food and the people. And the people I was working with were wonderful. I was there with my 6-month-old son, so it was a little tricky at times, but I had fun."
