



Two-suited opening bids are popular in Europe, and today's deal is from a recent tournament in Norway. These bids can be very effective on a given hand, but they also give the opponents a lot of information. This deal is from a pairs competition, where overtricks are crucial, and South was Harald Gjellastad.

East overtook the opening heart lead with the ace and shifted to the queen of clubs, won in dummy with the king. Declarer cashed the king of spades and led a spade to his ace, drawing trumps. Ten tricks were easy enough at this point, but South went after the important overtrick.


South ruffed his remaining heart in dummy, returned to his hand with a trump, and led the jack of diamonds. West covered with the king and dummy won the ace. South cashed dummy's queen of diamonds, leaving this position:



Playing West to be 5-5 in the red suits from the auction, South cashed dummy's ace of clubs and exited with the last diamond. West won and was forced to lead a red suit to give South a ruff-sluff. The overtrick gave declarer a well-earned top board.


