

The bidding:

Opening lead: Two of A

Declarer won the opening trump lead in hand with the nine and had to decide whether to try and ruff two clubs in dummy or set up dummy's hearts. He decided to go after the hearts and led the 10 of hearts at trick two. West won with his king and played a second trump, won perforce in dummy.

South continued with the queen of hearts from dummy, discarding a

club from hand while West won with his ace. West shifted to a low club—queen, king and ace. What now? Should South lead a trump to the table at this point, his contract would fail unless the hearts split 3-3. He could set up the hearts, but would have no quick entry to enjoy them.

Declarer found the solution. He led a low diamond to the board's queen, surrendering a trick to East's king! The defense was stymied. Should East play his last trump, South could ruff a heart, establishing the suit, and return to dummy with the jack of diamonds to cash the good hearts. Should East play a club instead, South would ruff on the table, ruff a heart with the jack of trumps and then lead the queen, drawing the last trump. Again, the jack of diamonds would provide the entry to the good hearts.

There are some fascinating variations that would have ensued had South, instead, elected to ruff two clubs in dummy. We leave it to interested readers to work them out.


