BRIDGE

Q 1- Neither vulnerable, as South, vou hold:

♦ O 6 ♥ A 8 4 2 ♦ 10 5 4 **♣** K O J 3

Left-hand opponent opens one diamond, passed around to you. What call would you make?

A - Some would bid one heart, but we prefer a chunkier suit when it is only four cards long. Bid one no trump. In the pass-out seat, as here, that call shows 11-14 points with a stopper. A shaky stopper in the opponent's minor suit is acceptable.

Q 2 - Neither vulnerable, as South, vou hold:

♠ A J 7 4 ♥ A J 8 ♦ 8 2 **♣** A 8 3 2

The bidding: WEST NORTH EAST SOUTH Pass 10 200* *Six hearts, 5-10 points

What call would you make?

A - You will probably end up in three no trump, but there is no rush to get there. Double first, negative, to see if you have a spade fit. If not, you can bid three no trump next.

O 3 - North-South vulnerable, as South, you hold:

♠ J 4 2 ♥ A 9 3 2 ♦ K Q J 7 6 **♣** 2

Right-hand opponent opens one club. What call would you make?

A - Double is possible, but we prefer to bid one diamond, getting our excellent suit into the auction and allowing partner to bid a major, if he has one.

O 4 - East-West vulnerable, as South. you hold:

♠ O 9 7 5 ♥ Void ♦ 10 9 5 3 2 **♣** J 9 8 3

The bidding:

NORTH EAST SOUTH WEST 2 Pass 2♦ Pass 2NT Pass

What call would you make?

A - Not much to brag about, but partner has shown 22 points or a bit more, so don't pass. Bid three clubs, Stayman, and hope to find a spade fit. Should you not find one, bid three no trump next and smile when you put down the dummy.

O 5 - Both vulnerable, as South, you hold:

♠ A Q J 3 ♥ 7 6 3 ♦ Q 8 2 **♣** J 5 3

Partner opens one no trump and right-hand opponent passes. What call would you make?

A - Even if you have a spade fit, it is not certain that spades will play better than no trump, and nine tricks are easier than 10. Bid three no trump.

Q 6 - North-South vulnerable, as South, you hold:

♦ Void ♥ A 10 6 3 ♦ A K 10 9 7 6 2 ♣ A 9

The bidding: SOUTH WEST NORTH EAST 14 10 20

What call would you make?

A - Distributional hands improve tremendously when their suit gets raised. This hand, already good, has become a giant. Bid five diamonds.


