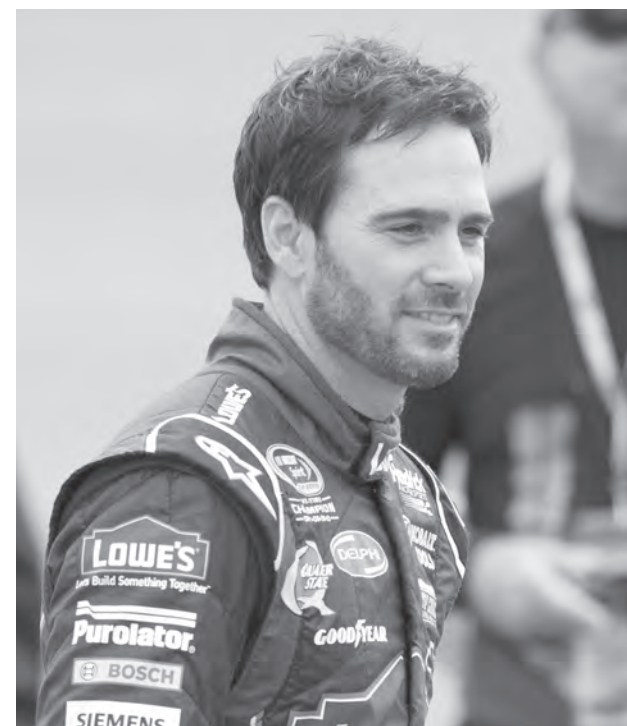

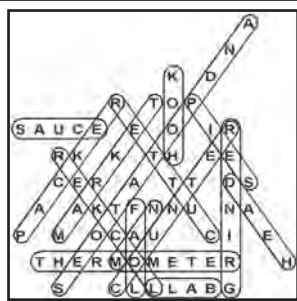

YouTube Stars Bring Their Innovative Satire to Comedy Central

Without a doubt, the most exciting development in entertainment has been the advent of video-sharing websites like Metacafe, Vimeo and YouTube. It's been a real game-changer that levels the playing field for aspiring filmmakers - with or without talent - who can now exhibit their productions before a worldwide audience at little or no cost, with the real possibility of gaining enough attention to launch a mainstream career. Such is the delusional dream of Florida brothers Ben (Lenny Jacobson) and Jack (Alex Anfanger) Dolfe, who remain confident that their crappy Internet videos will usher in the next cinematic movement, all while their day to day lives are filled with moments straight out of action thrillers on "Big Time in Hollywood, FL," premiering Wednesday at 9:30 p.m. on Comedy Central.

The uproariously funny half-hour show was created by Anfanger and director Dan

Schimpf, who are genuine online stars with such brilliant low-budget shorts as their "Next Time on Lonny" series. But while the efforts of the Dolfe brothers pale in comparison, they are just as committed to their craft, so when their parents (Stephen Tobolowsky, Kathy Baker) decide to kick their freeloading sons out of the house and force them to fend for themselves, they hatch an elaborate plan to maintain that support. Hiring a local actor (played by series' executive producer Ben Stiller), they scheme to bilk their parents out of \$20,000, and so set out on their grand and increasingly harrowing quest for stardom, approached video by dreadful video. Along with their simpleminded friend Del (Jon Bass), the Brothers Dolfe produce truly awful works that underscore the satirical savvy of Anfanger and Schimpf.

"I think they're funny as hell," says veteran film heavy Michael Madsen, who is well cast as an alcoholic private eye hired by the boys' parents to

keep track of their criminal activities.

"It's a ridiculously weird show," Stiller adds. "I mean, really. Like the tone, I don't even know how you describe the tone, and I don't know how people will respond to it. But I think that what's great about it is that it's really taking chances, and they have a very specific idea of what they're trying to do, and they're going for it. 100 percent commitment."

"If I can add to what Ben said, trust," notes Cuba Gooding Jr., who appears as a fictionalized version of himself on the series. "And I think that that was the main thing that got me aboard, because my agents called me and they said you have this offer to do this series on Comedy Central. I said, 'OK, great. Send it.' 'Well, before you read it, just understand, they want you to play yourself. They want you to play the character of Cuba Gooding Jr.' And I was like, 'I don't do that. I don't feel comfortable doing that.' And they were like, 'We get it, but just

watch the pilot.' I said, 'Fine.' And I watched it with my two sons, and I laughed harder watching them laugh at it than I did the pilot. It was just one of those wonderful moments where I was like, 'I am old now, because this is brilliant.' And after I met with them, I said, 'I'll do whatever you want me to do because I trust you all now,' and I think their team is a team of trust, and when you see the show you'll understand why my ass is out, because I trust these people."

Anfanger and Schimpf began collaborating on comedic shorts immediately after they were randomly paired as roommates in their freshman year at NYU's Tisch School of the Arts. "We were doing these just horrible, horrible things in New York," Anfanger relates, "and we decided to start working on something. We came up with these characters, and they're kind of like us, I guess. We wanted first to figure out what would be really fun characters to go on a journey with, and then to create an elaborate world that will foster the comedy."

"Mostly when I'm at home I watch a lot of dramas," Schimpf says in turn, "and over the past decade or so, you

started to see these big story arcs, these big storylines, and I loved what they were doing in terms of filling their universes. And I think that Alex and I both have a mutual love for telling big stories and trying to bridge that gap into comedy. I had these sort of like idiot

characters that kind of go on an odyssey and really, like, each episode just keeps growing and growing and expanding and expanding. And that, to me, was sort of like why I thought the idea would be fun. If you start small and you keep building the universe."

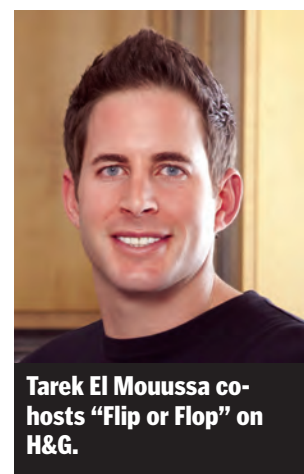

James Corden Hopes to Charm America

If you happened into a movie theater over the holidays, there's a good chance you saw James Corden starring opposite Meryl Streep and Emily Blunt in the musical "Into the Woods." The Tony and BAFTA Award-winning star is a multifaceted performer, and he writes and produces. On Monday, he takes on a new challenge as the host of "The Late Late Show with James Corden," airing at 11:37 p.m. on CBS.

With a successful film and television career, it might seem odd for Corden to take on something that's going to tie him down for several years. But he doesn't see it that way. "There's nothing more creative I think I'll ever do in my career than to try and make an hour of television every day," Corden says. "All of those things, that's a combination of probably, I don't know, three or four years of work. I bet if you added up all of the hours of that, it would be about six months of our show. So, in terms of creativity, I couldn't feel less like I'm put-

ting the brakes on and more like I'm putting my foot on the gas really. But I know in terms of the different things that I do in my career, I just feel like this is an opportunity for me. I'm from High Wycombe, which you've never heard of, in Buckinghamshire, and there is just no rhyme or reason why I should be given the opportunity to host a late-night talk show and talk to America every night, and hopefully try and make them smile before or more like whilst they fall asleep.

"People get really carried away about how quite fulfilling making a movie is," he jokes. "I mean, I love it, and there are times, particularly the last one, 'Into the Woods' is the greatest filming experience I've ever had. But that is not most filming experiences. Most of the time, you're sat in a trailer on a parking lot, freezing cold, you know, going to the toilet on a very low plastic toilet that you, like, flush where you use your foot. That's it. That's most of your day."

As excited as he is about the job, there are some personal sacrifices Corden's making.

Moving across the pond means leaving some of the people he loves behind.

"The things I'm going to miss are my parents and my friends, and I have a 3 year old son and 9 week old daughter, and if I think about how far I'm taking them away from their grandparents, it's enough to make me cry, so those are the things that I'll miss. And those are the reasons that I have to make it the very thing that it is, which is a wonderful opportunity to do something brilliant. When I think about missing things, I love West Ham United Football Club to bits, but they are not the things I feel far away from."

Corden hopes to bring something a little different to the late-night table. "My influences are, you know, Graham Norton, Chris Evans, Jonathan Ross, Michael Parkinson," Corden says. "My influences purely by location of where I grew up are not Johnny Carson or Cavett, Letterman, Leno. I never grew up with those guys every night. So, I hope that I could bring a flavor of the people whom I love and admire from home.

"I would love to introduce lots of people to American audiences, not just British performers who are my friends," he continues. "There are brilliant bands here who haven't been on TV whom I would love to give a platform. There are great comedians here, brilliant, brilliant comedians whom I would like to introduce to an audience and say, 'Get on board with this guy. I think you're going to love him.' Nothing would make me happier than that. Reggie Watt is going to run our house band; I feel lucky. I feel like the luckiest man on earth. I'm just going to get to sit and watch him every night. Do you know what I mean? I would walk to Brooklyn to watch him perform, and so to sit and to be in a room with him and him be in the absolute makeup of our show and the DNA of what it is, is the most exciting thing for me. If someone like Jack (Whitehall) happens to be in L.A. and fancies coming on and doing five minutes, I would love to introduce American audiences to such a talent."

It's mind boggling the preparation it takes to get a late-night talk show ready to air, but Corden is taking it in stride. "The truth is we could

prep for this show for a year," he says. "It's only in the doing of it that it's going to tell us what it is, and our audience has to take on the ownership of the show as much as we do. So, it's only in the getting up every day and making sure every day, and we're going to make mistakes, and we're going to get things wrong, but hopefully we're going to get something

right as well. And I think we have a really great shot with the team that we're putting together of making a show that finds its own audience, that finds a place, finds a group of people who go, 'This is the person I want to sit with as I cozy up in bed, and this is the person that's going to make me feel like everything's going to be all right.'"

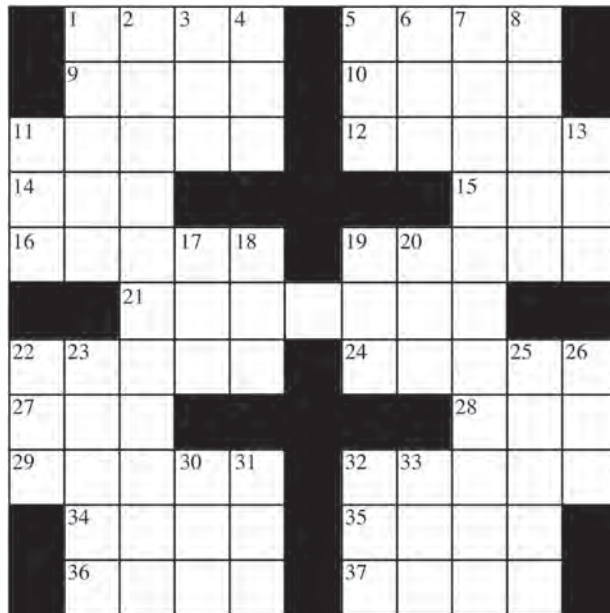

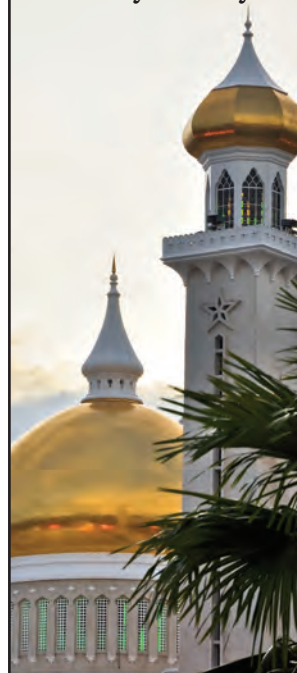
