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Legacy

A Wellborn family has walked the schools' halls for 47 years, and its last grad is his class' valedictorian

When Pauline Lloyd's grandson, Nathan Paul Holtman, walks across the football field at Walter Wellborn High School on May 21, she'll watch him — and her family — go out on top.

For the past 47 years, the 82-year-old Lloyd has claimed either a child or a grandchild enrolled at the high school. Holtman, 18, is the last of a long line of Lloyd's descendants who've walked the same halls, eventually graduating on the same field. He'll do so as valedictorian, the first of his family to earn the highest grade point average over the course of his high school career.

"I'm proud ... I can't say any more," Lloyd said Monday morning, just before her grandson accepted two aca-

demic scholarships to Mississippi State University in the high school's gym. Her lips quivered as she spoke, perhaps revealing emotion felt, but held back.

"Of course, I've had several go to college," she added.

She and her husband, James, whom she married in 1949, put all four of their children through college. Three of those children graduated from Wellborn High.

Lloyd's kids stuck around, had kids: Holtman is the son of her daughter, Lisa. He'll be the last of seven grandchildren (and three children) to receive a diploma — along with a rose from a bouquet prepared at Lloyd's flower shop, just down the road from the high school.

"That was one of his top priorities," Holtman said of his grandfather, who

died before he turned 2 but was known for his emphasis on higher education. "The question wasn't, 'Are you going?,' it was, 'Where are you going?'"

Holtman is decided: he's going to Mississippi State. He wants to be a doctor.

"I'm going to MSU for my basics, then Duke after," Holtman said recently. "Maybe do a residency in California ... I want to go all over the country."

Holtman earned more than \$50,000 in scholarship money to go to MSU, and said he's looking forward to starting college.

"I guess I look at it like a new beginning," he said during a phone interview. "I'm an 18-year-old guy... I kinda want to get out of the house for a while."

For her part, Lloyd stayed in Calhoun County.

Aside from a 10-year stint in Huntsville, where her husband worked as a pattern maker for the rocket program at Redstone Arsenal, Lloyd has lived in Wellborn all her life.

She was born where the Anniston Army Depot is now, and remembers when "202 was just a little strip." Before there was a Wellborn, she went to Eulaton Elementary School.

"My husband's grandfather owned all the property Wellborn schools are on now," she said.

She and James were together 49 years. Cancer separated them.

James loved the high school, though, and especially loved the

athletic program, Lloyd said. He drove a school bus for more than 25 years, and always volunteered to drive teams to football games.

After he passed away, Lloyd set up a \$1,000 scholarship in his name. She's given it away to a Wellborn student every year since 1999.

She'd brought an old shirt that used to belong to her husband to the scholarship signing. It was black, with the word "Wellborn" and a snarling panther embroidered in silver over the breast pocket.

It'd sat in a drawer since her husband died, she said.

"He won't ever wear it, but he'll keep it," Lloyd said. "That was his granddaddy's shirt, and it'll be a connection to Wellborn."
