### **BRIDGE**

**Q 1 -** Neither vulnerable, as South, you hold:

**♠** K 8 5 ♥ A 4 ♦ A O 10 4 3 **♣** K 7 6

The bidding: WEST NORTH EAST SOUTH Pass 200\* Pass

2. 34 Pass Pass \*Transfer to spades

What call would you make?

1NT

A - You have an absolute maximum with three-card support. Shout the good news by jumping to four spades. Partner is unlimited and might have slam ambitions.

O 2 - North-South vulnerable, as South, you hold:

**♠** O 5 ♥ K J 9 ♦ A J 5 3 2 **♣** J 8 6

The bidding: NORTH EAST

Pass 10 Pass 1. Pass

SOUTH

WEST

What call would you make?

A - Bid two no trump. This call at responder's second turn shows an invitational hand with 11-12 points. This hand is too soft to force to game.

O 3 - East-West vulnerable, as South. you hold:

**♠**85 ♥ A.I.96 ♦ A.43 ♣ 7643

Partner opens one diamond and righthand opponent doubles. What call would you make?

A - When an opponent doubles the opening bid, all calls at the one level show exactly the same thing as if the opponent had passed. Bid one heart.

**Q 4 -** Both vulnerable, as South, you hold:

**♦** K 8 6 4 ♥ 3 ♦ A Q J 10 3 **♣** J 9 5

The bidding: NORTH EAST SOUTH WEST 14 Pass Pass 10 1 Pass

What call would you make?

A - Should your system allow splinter bids, bid four hearts to show fourcard spade support, game-forcing values, and a singleton heart. If not, then bid four spades.

O 5 - North-South vulnerable, as South, you hold:

**♠** K 10 7 2 ♥ O 5 3 ♦ 10 5 **♣** 10 8 7 2

Partner opens one club and righthand opponent passes. What call would you make?

A - Some would pass with only five high-card points, but we like those three 10's. Bid one spade.

**O** 6 - East-West vulnerable, as South. you hold:

**▲** A 4 ♥ 9 6 5 ♦ K 9 7 6 4 **♣** 10 4 2

Partner opens one no trump and right-hand opponent passes. What call would you make?

A - This hand is not quite worth a game invitation and we are happy to play in no trump. Pass.




