

5k, 10k Horseshoe Hills Run is part of this year's festival

This year's Potato Festival features a 5k and 10k Horseshoe Hills Run, sponsored by the Manhattan Athletic Club.

Runners must register and sign in by 7:30 a.m. Saturday at the Club, 220 Wooden Shoe Lane (just off the Interstate in Manhattan). Cost is \$15 for runners under age 18 and \$20 for adults. Includes a T-shirt.

Runners will travel by vehicle to the race venue at

Gallatin River Ranch in the Horseshoe Hills and the race will get underway at around 8 a.m. The 10k is an "out and back" race, a "little bit harder" than the 5k, and will start and finish at the top of the hill.

The 5k will start at the top of the hill and finish at the Gallatin River Ranch gate house on Nixon Gulch Road, just across the Gallatin River from Manhattan.
