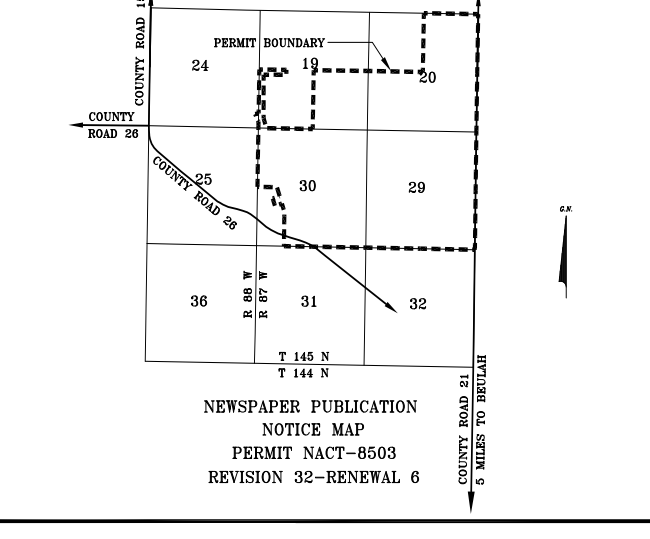

Once a minimum of 7 days of cure time on the rejuvenator or new asphalt pavement has transpired, the Contractor shall complete the pavement markings for each phase. If the Contractor does not complete the Prerequisites to Substantial Completion within 30 working days, liquidated damages will be assessed per working day for every day beyond this timeframe.
