PUBLIC NOTICE OF SURFACE MINING APPLICATION NEW SITE ADDITION TO PERMIT

Meramec Aggregates, Inc., 527 E. Independence, Union, MO 63084 has applied for a new site addition to their permit from the Department of Natural Resources, Land Reclamation Commission, to mine sand and gravel on 60 acres of land located in Franklin County, Section 9, Township 41N, Range 1E.

This operation will be conducted during the approximate dates of 4/1/2014 to 12/31/2014.

Written comments, a request for an informal public meeting, and/or a formal courtroom hearing may be made by any person

with a direct, personal interest in one or more of the factors that the Missouri Land Reclamation Commission may consider in issuing a permit, as required by The Land Reclamation Act, sections 444.760 to 444.790 RSMo. The commission may grant a formal courtroom hearing if the commission finds, based on good faith evidence provided to them, that someone's health, safety or livelihood will be unduly impaired by the issuance of the permit. In order to be granted a formal courtroom hearing, the health, safety and livelihood impact must be within the authority of an environmental law or regulation administered by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Project Manager of Franklin County Transportation Council, Inc. (FCTC) on April 17, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. to consider a project partially funded with federal funds to be grant administered by the Missouri Department of Transportation, pursuant to re-authorizing legislation for surface transportation programs in Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21).

1. Purchase of six (6) buses. Of these vehicles, four (4) will all be lift-equipped, while two (2) will be 24-passenger. They will serve residents of Franklin County.

2. Requesting financial assistance in an amount necessary to complete funding and operate in Franklin County.

3. The location of the project will be to serve residents of Franklin County in Missouri.

4. The total estimated cost of the project is \$969,588.00 (capital and operating); Federal Funds \$400,550.00; Local Funds \$569,038.00.

5. The source of the local match will be from privately generated local funds (capital); unrestricted federal funds, local cash, donations and in-kind match (operating).

6. At the hearing, FCTC will afford an opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard regarding social, economic, environmental aspects of the project and the needs of limited English proficient persons. Interested persons may submit orally, or in writing, evidence and recommendations with respect to said project. If no person(s) request to give either oral or written statements three days prior to the public hearing, the applicant is not required to hold the public hearing.

7. Organizations interested in the proposed service may request information concerning the project from the applicant.

8. FCTC, Inc. does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, or age in employment or provision of services.
