## **2013 OFFICIAL RULES**

- 1. The *Missourian's* Summer Reading Contest is open to children, ages 4-15 when entry is submitted, who reside in the *Missourian's* circulation area.
- 2. Entries must be made on the 2013 *Missourian* Summer Reading Contest Official Entry Form. All entries become the sole and exclusive property of the contest sponsors and will not be returned.
- 3. You may include ALL the children in one family on one Official Entry Form.
- 4. Official Entry Forms are inside the Summer Reader Booklet, and are available free at *Missourian* offices, Bank of Franklin County branches, area libraries and at the Washington Town & County Fair office.
- 5. To be considered complete, Official Entry Form must contain 7 Fair icons corresponding to each chapter of the summer reading feature published in *The Missourian*.
- 6. Entries may be mailed or delivered to the *Missourian* Summer Reading Club, c/o Washington Town & Country Fair, 323 W. Main St., Washington, MO 63090.
- 7. The Washington Town & Country Fair will mail a confirmation letter to each child from whom a complete Official Entry Form is received.
- 8. Prizes will be awarded from all entries <u>received</u> on or before July 22, 2013. Entries received after this date will not be considered.
- 9. The Washington Town & Country Fair, the Missourian Publishing Company and Bank of Franklin County are not responsible for late, illegible or lost Entry Forms or confirmation letters.
- 10. Participants will be awarded admission to the 2013 Washington Town & Country Fair on Thursday, August 8, 2013.
- 11. Tickets are not transferable to another child.
- The Grand Prize Reader Reward Basket will be awarded in a random drawing of all Summer Reading Contest participants, but reader MUST be **present** at the Reader Recognition Ceremony at 5 p.m., Thursday, August 8, 2013, to win.
- 13. There is no purchase necessary to participate. Official Entry Forms are available inside the Summer Reader Booklet, available at *Missourian* offices in Washington, Union and St. Clair, area libraries, Bank of Franklin County branches and at the Washington Town & Country Fair office. The story can be read at public libraries and photocopies of weekly Fair icons are acceptable.
