NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Project Manager of the Franklin County Transportation Council, Inc. (FCTC) on April 19, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. to consider a project partially funded with federal funds by the Missouri Department of Transportation, pursuant to Section 5311 of Title 49, United States Code.

1. Capital Project — to be funded from Section 5339 of Title 49, United States Code: Federal funding of \$159,593.60 is requested for the purchase of four (4) passenger buses, four (4) of which will be equipped to transport people with disabilities, total cost \$199,492.00.

2. This project will assist general public transportation needs through the purchase of these vehicles for FCTC. All vehicles will be used in Franklin County.

3. The location of the project will be to serve residents in Franklin County, Missouri.

4. Operating Project — to be funded from Section 5311 of Title 49, United States Code: The total estimated cost of the project is \$701,600. Total federal funds requested: \$180,000; local funds and fares to be used for the project: \$521,600.

5. The source of the local match will be from privately generated local funds (capital); unrestricted federal funds, local cash, donations and in-kind match (operating).

6. At the hearing, FCTC will afford an opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard regarding social, economic, and environmental aspects of the project. Interested persons may submit oral or written evidence and recommendations with respect to said project. If no person(s) request to give either oral or written statements three days prior to the public hearing, the applicant is not required to hold the public hearing.

7. Organizations interested in

the proposed service may request information from the applicant.

8. FCTC does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, or age in employment or provision of services.
