Hospice of the Valley provides compassionate care to people with life-limiting illnesses and their families in West Valley communities.

Core services are provided by a hospice team consisting of a physician, nurse, social worker, chaplain, home care aide and volunteer. Help is available 24/7.

Physicians assess the patient, prescribe medications, and manage symptoms; nurses make in-home visits as often as needed. Home care aides provide personal care services. Social workers help with advance care planning and offer emotional support. Chaplains provide spiritual counseling to those who request it. Volunteers assist patients and support families.

Most hospice care is provided in the patient's home; the West Valley is served by staff at the agency's clinical

office in Peoria. Patients also receive care in skilled nursing facilities, assisted living facilities and group homes.

The agency offers special programs to patients with dementia, cancer, heart and lung disease.

In addition to hospice care, the agency offers Arizona Palliative Home Care, a program for patients with late-stage chronic illness who are not quite ready for hospice but want assistance at home. We depend on our paychecks to cover our expenses: groceries, housing, transportation-and those are just the basics. When a person is unable to work due to a disabling injury or illness, the financial impact of lost paychecks can be devastating.

An income interruption due to a disability isn't something you can afford to ignore. According to the Social Security Administration, more than one in four 20-year-olds will become disabled at some point before they retire. And 50 percent of working Americans would suffer financial issues in less than a month if they lost their paycheck. Twenty-five percent would have problems immediately-within a week-according to the Life and Health Insurance Foundation for Education (LIFE Foundation).

Here are some steps you can take right now:

Help protect your paycheck - When the unexpected happens, disability insurance can help. Disability insurance essen-



tially replaces a portion of your income-generally about 40-60 percent-if you can't work due to accident or sickness, says Matthew Tassey, CLU, ChFC, LUTCF and past chairman of the LIFE Foundation. "Disability insurance should be a priority," he says. "We always have expenses."

Find the right fit -There's no one-plan-fitsall approach to disability insurance. Some employers offer disability coverage, whether long-term or short-term, so check with your company's benefits manager to see if you have coverage, and if so, what that coverage provides. If you don't have it, you can purchase an individual plan.

Some terms to know when shopping for disability insurance:

* Elimination period: Refers to the length of time you need to be disabled before you receive payment.

* Benefit period: Refers to the length of time benefits will last.

"The quicker the money

comes your way and the longer it pays, the more expensive it is," Tassey says. And he points out that, on average, a 30-year-old non-smoking healthy male can receive \$1,000 a month up to age 65 for about \$30 a month. His benefits would begin after 90 days.

Learn more - In recognition of National Disability Income Insurance Month in May, the LIFE Foundation has created a website that explains the basics of disability insurance, contains video testimonials from real people and provides calculators for determining how much insurance you need and estimating your lifetime earnings. You can also calculate your personal disability quotient online.

Spring is here, it is time to move, enjoy life, and smell the roses ... through exercise.







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Beatrice Keller Clinic explains Mohs Micrographic Surgery

New treatments for skin cancer are appearing and evolving rapidly in recent years. However, one surgical technique has more than stood the test of time. Developed by Dr. Frederick Mohs in the 1930s, Mohs micrographic surgery has, with a few refinements, come to be embraced over the past decade by an increasing number of surgeons for an ever-widening variety of skin cancers.

Today, Mohs surgery has come to be accepted as the single most effective technique for removing Basal Cell Carcinomas and Squa-

mous Cell Carcinomas (BCCs and SCCs), the two most common skin cancers. It accomplishes sparing the greatest amount of healthy tissue while also most completely expunging cancer cells. Cure rates for BCC and SCC are an unparalleled 98% or higher with Mohs, significantly better than the rates for standard excision or any other accepted method.

The reason for the technique's success is its simple elegance. Mohs differs from other techniques in that microscopic examination of all excised tissues occurs during rather than after the surgery, thereby eliminating the need to "estimate" how far out or deep the roots of the skin cancer go. This allows the Mohs surgeon to remove all cancer cells while sparing as much normal tissue as possible. The procedure entails removing one thin layer of tissue at a time. As each layer is removed, its margins are studied under a microscope for the presence of cancer cells. If the margins are cancer-free, the surgery is ended. If not, more tissue is removed from the margin where the cancer cells were found, and the procedure is repeated until all the margins of the final tissue sample examined are clear of cancer. This way, Mohs surgery eliminates the guesswork in skin cancer removal, producing the best therapeutic and cosmetic results.

In the past, Mohs was rarely chosen for Melanoma surgery for fear that some microscopic melanoma cells might be missed and end up spreading around the body (metastasizing). However, efforts to improve the Mohs surgeon's ability to identify melanoma cells

have led to special stains that highlight these cells, making them much easier to see under the microscope. Thus, more Mohs surgeons are now using this procedure with certain melanomas. With the rates for melanoma and other skin cancers continuing to skyrocket, Mohs will play an ever more important role in the coming decades. © 2013 The Skin Cancer Foundation
