FOR SEARCH WARRANT

13 Missoula Police Detective Dean Chrestenson, duly appointed and  
14 acting Police Officer for the City of Missoula Police Department, being first  
15 duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and says:  
16

17 That he has good reason to believe that the offense of DELIBERATE  
18 HOMICIDE, a Felony, in violation of MCA 45-5-102 has been committed.  
19

20 That he has good reason to believe and does believe that in and upon the  
21 body of **Markus Kaarma** who is currently located at the Missoula County  
22 Detention Center, 2340 Mullan Road, Missoula, Montana. The above is  
23 located within the City Limits of Missoula, County of Missoula, State of  
24 Montana, there have been and are now located certain items of evidence of  
25  
26  
27

1 the crime, particularly described as being:

2 **A sample of human blood to be used to used for testing the**  
3 **concentration of alcohol, dangerous drugs, other drugs and/or**  
4 **intoxicating substances or a combination of the above individual**  
5 **and any other evidence which reasonably relates to the crime, a**  
6 **motive for the crime and/or the mental state of the offender.**

7 That the facts which are the grounds of this application and upon which  
8 applicant relies to establish probable cause for the issuance of a search  
9 warrant are:

- 10 1. On April 27, 2014, Missoula Police Detectives were searching the  
11 residence at 2607 Deer Canyon Court with the authority of a search  
12 warrant when the discovered a mason style glass jar containing  
13 marijuana in the pantry in the kitchen.  
14
- 15 2. On April 27, 2014, Missoula Police Detective Mark Blood was  
16 conducting a neighborhood canvas of the area around 2607 Deer  
17 Canyon Court. He met with neighbor Suzanne R. Klise who advised  
18 the wife of Markus Kaarma, told her that her husband smokes  
19 marijuana in the garage.  
20
- 21 3. Suzanne R. Klise also stated Markus Kaarma's wife advised her that  
22 on a previous burglary of the garage the suspects had taken all the  
23 marijuana and marijuana pipes out of the garage.  
24
- 25 4. Alcohol, and dangerous drugs, are intoxicating substances alone or  
26
- 27

1 in a combination of the above are effervescent evidence and the  
2 body is constantly metabolizing these substances from the blood  
3 stream.  
4

5 Based upon the above information, Detective Dean Chrestenson  
6 believes that Markus Kaarma may have been impaired by alcohol,  
7 dangerous drugs, other drugs, intoxicating substances or a combination of  
8 the above, at the time of the incident and that evidence has been and is  
9 now to be found within Markus Kaarma's blood.

12 THEREFORE, the Applicant requests that a Search Warrant be issued,  
13 authorizing the Applicant to direct a qualified medical professional to  
14 obtain the human blood sample from the body of Markus Kaarma, who is  
15 currently located at 2340 Mullan Road the Missoula County Detention  
16 Center, in Missoula, Montana, seize it and have it analyzed at the  
17 Montana State crime lab.

4 Road, Missoula, Montana, to seize it, and have it analyzed at the Montana  
5 State crime lab. Further, applicant is directed to give a receipt for evidence  
6 seized, prepare a written inventory verified by you of the evidence seized, to  
7 deliver the inventory before me, all in the manner required by law.
