In light of the recent 53 page opinion issued late Friday afternoon, December 20, 2013, by Federal Judge Robert Shelby, striking down Utah's constitutional provision defining marriage and the related state statutes defining marriage, Cache County and the Cache County Clerk has closed the Cache County Clerk's Office to sort out the legal issues and confusion created in the wake of Judge Shelby's opinion.

Furthermore, the governor of the State of Utah, commenting on the chaotic state created by the opinion has affirmed that the State will seek a stay of the Federal Judge's order and will be appealing the decision to the 10th Circuit Court of Appeals.

Given the status of the pending motion for a stay and the appeal that will be filed by the State of Utah, the Cache County Clerk's office will be closed until further notice.
