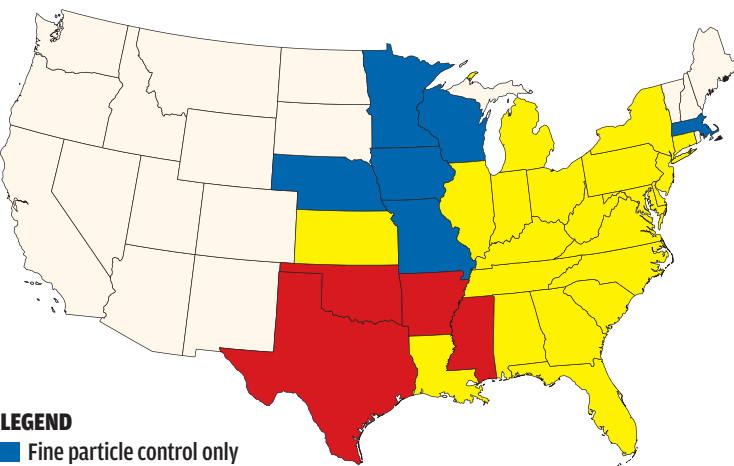


THE TRANSPORTATION RULE

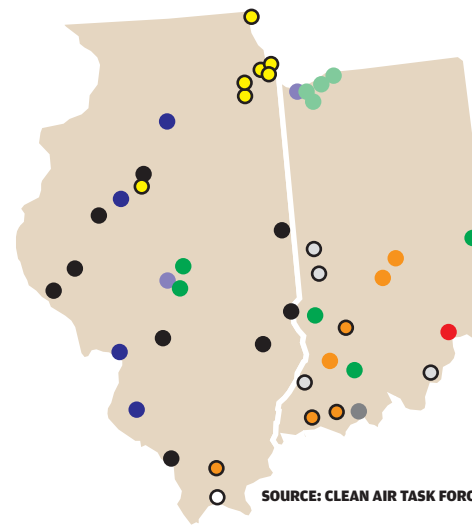


LEGEND

COAL-BURNING PLANTS | Color coded by operator

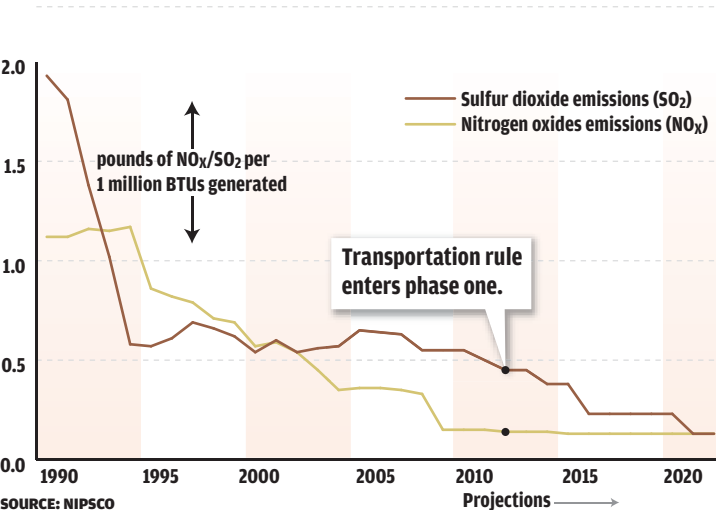

SCRUBBERS | How they work

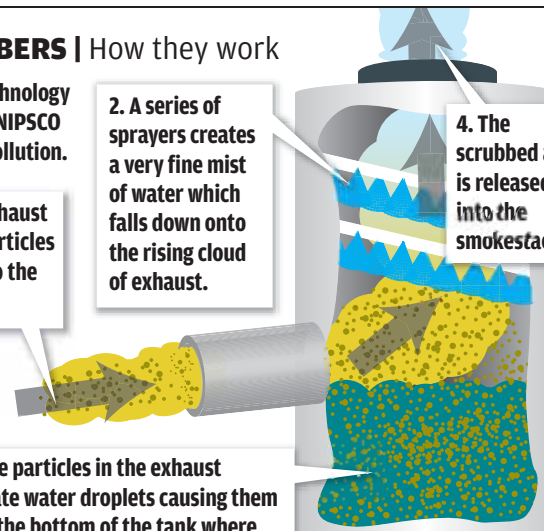
Similar technology is used by NIPSCO to lower pollution.

1. Coal exhaust rich in particles flows into the scrubber.

2. A series of sprayers creates a very fine mist of water which falls down onto the rising cloud of exhaust.

3. The fine particles in the exhaust accumulate water droplets causing them to fall to the bottom of the tank where they are collected and disposed of.

4. The scrubbed air is released into the smokestack.
