New abandoned mine land projects in Mahaska County

FAIRFIELD Pathfinders Resource Conservation and Development, in partnership with the Mahaska Soil and Water Conservation District, received three Watershed Cooperative Agreement grants from the Department of U.S. Interior's Office Surface Mining.

Two \$100,000 grants were awarded to help fund reclamation of the "Meyer" and "Memmelaar" Abandoned Mine Land sites in Mahaska County. Another \$200,000 grant was awarded to help fund the "Logan" AML reclamation. Other project partin the Iowa ners Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship

Division Soil Conservation and County Mahaska Secondary Roads.

Surface coal mines that ceased operations before 1977 were not required to be "reclaimed" by the operator once the mining stopped. This means an area strip-mined for coal was often left with large piles of the overburden that was stripped away so coal could be extracted. These are areas are referred to as "unreclaimed" or "abandoned mine land."

Iowa has more than 230 unreclaimed mine sites affecting 12-13,000 acres. The Meyer site is 16.6 acres and located just west of the city of Oskaloosa. The Memmelaar site is 11

acres and located south and east of the city of Leighton. Acid mine drainage from both sites affects negatively Muchakinock Creek. The Logan site is 98 acres and. to date, is the largest reclamation project to be taken on as a single reclamation project in Iowa. The Logan project is located 5 miles northeast Eddyville and will mitigate acid mine drainage affecting Turkey Run and Bluff Creek.

Unreclaimed mine lands present several environmental and aesthetic problems. These include exposed remnant coal leading to acid mine drainage and acid mine drainage lowering the pH in receiving waterbodies

which negatively affects have two more reclamaaquatic life and reduces biodiversity. In addition, acidic soils do not support the growth of vegetation so landscapes look barren and the soil continues to runoff without vegetation to hold it in place. Lastly, dangerous "highwalls" and large, steep spoil piles from mining activity can be hazardous to people and animals traversing the site.

While reclamation provides important environmental benefits, it's also expensive. \$300,000 in grant dollars are being leveraged with another \$2.64 million to complete these three reclamation projects. "Reclamation continues to be a pricey endeavor," says Pathfinders RC&D Executive Director Detra Dettmann. "With reclamation costing \$15,000 -\$20,000 per acre, every grant dollar secured helps complete more of this important work in Iowa."

To date, Pathfinders RC&D has partnered on

more than 30 AML projects in six counties, receiving over \$3 million in grant dollars from the Office of Surface Mining. "This is some of the most rewarding our nonprofit has been involved in," states Dettmann. "The changes before and after are very dramatic."

Pathfinders RC&D is a nonprofit organization that assists local communities with initiatives related to natural resource conservation and rural economic development. Pathfinders RC&D has served southeast Iowa since 1978.

ARTIFACT

Do you know what this is?

OSKALOOSA This past week's artifact from the Nelson Pioneer Farm is an Edison Phonograph.

Several readers made guesses as to the identity of the artifact.

Dorothy Vos wrote via email: "The artifact in the shopper is an Edison home cylinder phonograph player. It was invented around 1875 during the time Edison was developing the telephone and telegraph. The small round cylinders had the recorded music stored on them. There are many types of these cylinder players."

Henrietta Veldhuizen also wrote via email: "I think the mystery artifact in the Herald of April 16 is an Edison Phonograph

with cylinder and horn." Myrna Piersel wrote via email: "That is an old Edison Phonograph from around 1900. The cylinder records were interesting and worked well. I used to have a big collection of the records and an old player but don't know what happened to it. I could spend a lot of hours with it as a kid."


Nelson Pioneer Farm Curator Kelly Halbert did some research on the artifact. She wrote: "Edison Phonograph

What do telephones, telegraphs, cement, movie phonographs, cameras, ore separators, and light bulbs have in common? Thomas A. Edison! The inventor had something to do with each of these products as well as over 1000 others.

This week's artifact, The Edison Phonograph and record player, was a popular and affordable source of music and entertainment in 1900. Invented in 1877, the first recording was of himself reciting Mary Had a Little Lamb.

The phonograph was a device developed for the mechanical recording reproduction of sound. Using tin foil cylinders as a medium, Edison used one needle for recording and another needle for playing the impressions of sound.

"The sound vibrations waveforms are recorded as corresponding physical deviations of a groove engraved or impressed into the surface of a rotating cylinder or disc. To recreate the sound, the surface is similarly rotated while a playback stylus traces the groove and is therefore vibrated by it, very faintly reproducing the



recorded sound. In early acoustic phonographs, the stylus vibrated a diaphragm which produced sound waves which were coupled to the open air through a

flaring horn." Many inventors has worked to record sounds, but Edison was the first to create a way to play back the recordings. 




Sash making kids happy
