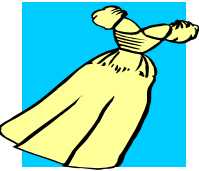

This collection is for LEAVES ONLY.

DROP-OFF: Leaves & grass clippings can be dropped off at the Galloway Road Compost Facility.

HOURS: Wednesday-Saturday, 8AM-2:30PM

OPTION: Compost on your property—Call 652-8657 ext. 10 for details

Non-Recyclable Plastics

Includes: PVC pipe/ tubing, vinyl siding, plastic drums/ pesticide containers, plastic stretch film, Styrofoam*, poly-coated paper (juice & milk cartons) water hoses.

Place in with your regular trash or call your hauler for special pickup.

*NOTE ON STYROFOAM "PEANUTS" : Most mailing and packing services would love to have them.

CURBSIDE & DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Put Cans/Bottles/Plastics/Cardboard/Paper Together

Cans & Bottles

Includes: Glass bottles & jars (all colors), steel, aluminum, aerosol & empty, dry paint cans. Remove lids; leave the labels on. **DO NOT INCLUDE:** Window glass, light bulbs, mirror glass, drinking glasses or ceramics...place in with regular trash.



Plastic #s

Includes: Soda bottles, milk/water jugs, laundry/dishwashing detergent bottles, plastic jars, microwave trays, yogurt containers, small flower pots. **DO NOT INCLUDE:** Plastic toys*, large flower pots & pails*, Styrofoam, vinyl siding, razors, lighters... place in regular trash. *Large flower pots & plastic toys can be brought for Rigid Plastic recycling.

Paper/Cardboard

Includes: Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, office paper, brown paper bags, food boxes (like pasta & cereal), gift boxes; paper egg cartons, hardback books (**no covers**), pizza boxes (**no food residue**), corrugated (brown) cardboard. **Corrugated cardboard . NO PLASTIC BAGS!**



DO NOT INCLUDE: Wrapping paper, milk cartons, juice boxes, ...place in with regular trash.



DROP OFF ONLY! Rechargeable Household Batteries

Includes: Nickel Cadmium (NI-CD) Nickel Metal Hydride, Mercury Oxide, Lithium Ion (Li-ion) and small sealed lead (PB) batteries. These can be found in cordless power tools, cellular & cordless phones, lap top computers and camcorders. Place in a clear plastic bag and bring to either recycling drop -off area.

GALLOWAY ROAD DROP OFF ONLY!

Rigid Plastics

Includes: Laundry baskets, buckets, , trash cans, plastic toys, "kiddie" pools, pet carriers, coolers, VHS tapes, CDs & DVD's /cases, clear molded blister packaging, flower pots/trays, lawn furniture, plastic auto bumpers. **DO NOT INCLUDE:** PVC Pipe, vinyl siding, plastic bags, water hoses.
