

Tutoring in local school districts

Chart shows the districts required to offer tutoring in 2008-09, the number of students eligible in the district, the amount of Title I federal funds available per student and the number of students who received tutoring, attended at least 80 percent of tutoring sessions, and showed improved academic performance. In large districts with multiple schools only the specific schools that did not meet state standards were required to offer tutoring, so the number of eligible students may vary.
