

# ADVANCED PLACEMENT 2011

The chart shows the number of students enrolled in Advanced Placement courses in area high schools in 2010-11, the number of AP tests taken that year, the number of tests scored 3 or higher, and the percentage of tests scored 3 or higher. Some students may have taken more than one class or test and are counted more than once. Tests are scored from 1 to 5, and students must earn at least a 3 to have it considered for college credit.
