LEAD ATLANTIC CITY TOMORROW (LEAD ACT), a public policy leadership development program, is a ten-month seminar and interactive program taking place from October through June. The 2012-2013 schedule will be released in September and each seminar will last one day, except for the January seminar which lasts 1.5 days. Times of the seminars are from 8am to 5pm. An interview may be required in addition to this application.

Participants are required to attend all seminars. To graduate, Fellows may miss no more than 1.5 seminar days during the year. Any participant missing more may be asked to withdraw from the program without refund of tuition. Candidates must have the support and commitment of their employers, as indicated by supervisor's signature below.

Tuition for the 2012-2013 program is \$200. A \$100 deposit must be received by the first seminar class in order to be considered a participant in the 2013 class. Full tuition must be paid by November 30, 2012. Financial assistance, and/or payment plan may be available.
