Q1 The candidates for President are Democrat Hillary Clinton and Republican Donald Trump. If the election were today, who would you vote for?

Hillary Clinton..... 45%
Donald Trump..... 43%
Not sure..... 12%

Q2 The candidates for U.S. Senate are Democrat Patty Judge and Republican Chuck Grassley. If the election was today, who would you vote for?

Patty Judge..... 43%
Chuck Grassley..... 49%
Not sure..... 8%

Q3 Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Merrick Garland?

Favorable..... 15%
