Wine and Walleye Pro-Am Fishing Tournament Saturday, August 27th

Anglers will set sail at 6:15 am in hopes of reeling in the big catch and earning a prize in the annual pro-am walleye & steelhead tournament. A mandatory captain's meeting is held at 7:00p.m. on Friday, August 26th on the Transient Dock.

Registration fees:

\$50 per person, amateur division \$200 per boat, pro division

Tournament winners will be decided based on the total length of five (5) walleye. In the event of a tie, the longest individual walleye of the five will determine the winner. If the tie hasn't been broken, the individual length of the next longest fish will be used (second, third, fourth, fifth) until a winner is determined.

In the steelhead category, the longest individual steelhead will determine the winner. In the event of a tie, weight of the steelhead will determine the winner.

The pro division includes any boat with an active charter captain on board. Pre-registration and a \$50 deposit is required, with the balance paid at the mandatory captain's meeting on Friday, August 26th.








5K and Guppy Run Saturday, August 27th Sponsored by AQUA.

Registration for the Guppy Run will take place on Walnut Boulevard at Point Park beginning at 7:30am. The Guppy Run is a one-quarter mile race for children age 10 and under. The race will take place at 8:30 am on Walnut Boulevard. All 'guppies' will receive a ribbon and trophies will be awarded to the top boy and girl. The cost is \$1 per guppy.

Registration for the 5K will take place near the Lift Bridge in the Ashtabula Harbor beginning at 7:30am. The 5K run/walk starts at 9 am at the Lift Bridge and winds through the historic Ashtabula Harbor, ending at the finish line in the sand at Walnut Beach. The top three racers in each age group will receive Wine and Walleye medals, and the overall male and female race winners will each receive a trophy.
