Don Witherow, 81, of Battle Ground, WA went home to be with our Lord on August 9, 2012. He was born in San Francisco, CA on May 11, 1931. Don lived in California and met the love of his life, Mary Ann Jackson, and they were married on August 31, 1951. Shortly after they were married, Don received the draft notice to serve his country during the Korean War in the U.S. Army from 1952-1954 as a railroad engineer in the Transportation Corp.
