CALLER STATED THAT THERE WAS A FIRE AT THE SCRAP YARD, THE FIRE RETARDANT MATERIAL AND SEVERAL OTHER MATERIALS THAT RELEASED FROM THE VEHICLES WERE WASHED ONTO THE GROUND. THE MATERIALS THAT WERE ON FIRE WERE MOTOR OIL TIRE RUBBER AND GASOLINE FROM SEVERAL VEHICLES IN THE YARD, SEVERAL AGENCIES RESPONDED TO THE INCIDENT, THE FIRE WAS EXTINGUISHED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, NO INJURIES AND NO FATALITIES.

The air was not being affect off site. When I retruned to plant at 1400, FDs where starting to leave. Alina stayed for closing meetings and I left at 1430, leaving her meters incase she needed them.
