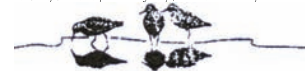

'Star Car' show coming to Coquille for Relay for Life fundraiser

COQUILLE — What do the 1966 Batmobile, the Back to the Future DeLorean Time Machine and the Star Wars Z-Wing Carfighter with an R2-D2 unit have in common? They and several other "star cars" will be on display at the first-ever American Cancer Society of South Coos County Spirit of Hope Car and Motorcycle Show.

The event will be held from noon to 5 p.m. Saturday, June 29, at the track and parking lot of Coquille High School, 499 W. Central, Coquille. Admission is free. Collectors and hobbyists also can enter their own car or motorcycle for a small fee, which is tax deductible to the American Cancer Society. Registration for those entries is at 11 a.m. Also, anyone interested is welcome to participate in the Relay For Life following the car show. Opening ceremonies begin at 5 p.m.

"This is a one-of-a-kind experience that Coos County has never seen before," said Becky Crim, who, along with her 17-year-old son Grant, a three-time cancer survivor, is organizing the show.

The car line-up includes: The 1966 Batmobile; The Back to the Future DeLorean Time Machine; Herbie the Love Bug; Star Wars Z-Wing Carfighter with R2-D2 unit; Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtle Party Van; Bumblebee from Transformers; Tow Mater (He may be bringing a friend — stay tuned!); Members of The 501st Legion of Stormtroopers and the Rebel Legion; ObiShawn and Master Yoda

Crim said a fun day will continue into the night with the Relay For Life. In addition to the star cars, ObiShawn, who works with NASA Space Camp, will be giving lightsaber lessons at the show and relay. Master Yoda will be on hand to help.

In addition, there will be food, music and activities as well as relevant movie items for sale, all of which will help raise money for the American Cancer Society. There will be raffles for prizes, a 50/50 drawing and raffles for a ride in some of the cars. In addition, photos will be available in the some of the cars for a donation to ACS.

"It is unlikely that you will have an opportunity to see a show like this again and you will probably never have a chance to sit or ride in these cars again," Crim said. "We urge you not to miss out on this event!"

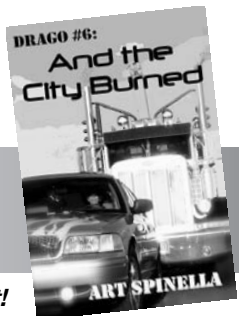

June Library Art on Display

The June art display at the Bandon Public Library features Lorna Logan with photographs in the hall and the wreaths of Eileen Quinn in the glass cases.

Peace•Love•Wreaths presents “A Bandon Beach Walk.” Rediscover a beachcomber’s treasure — shells, driftwood, agates and beach glass — in hand crafted wreaths and swags.

“The wreath, to me, has always been very symbolic,” said Quinn. “It’s a classic piece that never goes out of style.”

Through the winter months, Quinn walks Bandon’s beaches and waterfront, gathering materials and ideas. The wreaths she created for “A Bandon Beach Walk” capture all the hallmarks of a day on the coast.

“The wreaths are beautiful in all their natural colors. That’s what I love.”

Visitors to Bandon’s Old Town Marketplace will find Quinn at her studio table Fridays and Saturdays. For Quinn, each dried herbal sprig holds a history of culinary or medicinal use. Every shell recalls a journey through the sea. Quinn’s artistic journey is complete when she helps clients bring the natural world into their own personal spaces.

“One of my earliest memories is standing on a stool beside my father in the dim red light of his darkroom watching the ghost of an image appear, the grays becoming blacks on white paper, the air thick with chemicals, developer and fixer,” Logan said.

“Thus began my fascination with image, drawn or painted or caught with the camera. The process is simpler today with computers and digital cameras, quicker and accessible to almost everyone.

“The image is a reflection of the mind behind the camera, at times manipulated, at times purely a record of what was. I’m still fascinated.”

The library is located at 1204 11th St. S.W. in City Park and the displays will be up through June 30.

Bandon Time Capsule Seeks Submissions

THE PORT of Bandon is accepting items to put in the 100-year time capsule it plans to bury on Saturday, Sept. 14, as part of its centennial celebration.

Submissions will be accepted through July 31 and the container will be buried near the port offices in the historic Coquille River Lifesaving Station, 390 First Street S.W.

A reception for the public, port friends and partners is being planned to coincide with the interment of the stainless steel capsule, which has a capacity of about 2 cubic feet.

Gina Dearth, port general manager, explained that before the box is

welded shut, it will be purged with dry argon gas to help prevent oxidation or acidic reaction within the contents.

“We’re told this is a specialized process that’s used in the food, chemical, cryogenic and pharmaceutical industries,” she said. “According to the manufacturer, the contents of our capsule will last virtually forever.”

Public submissions, which must be limited in size due to the container’s capacity, should be intended to inform people in 2113 about Bandon’s culture in 2013.

“Or it could be advice or a small heirloom that you wish you could

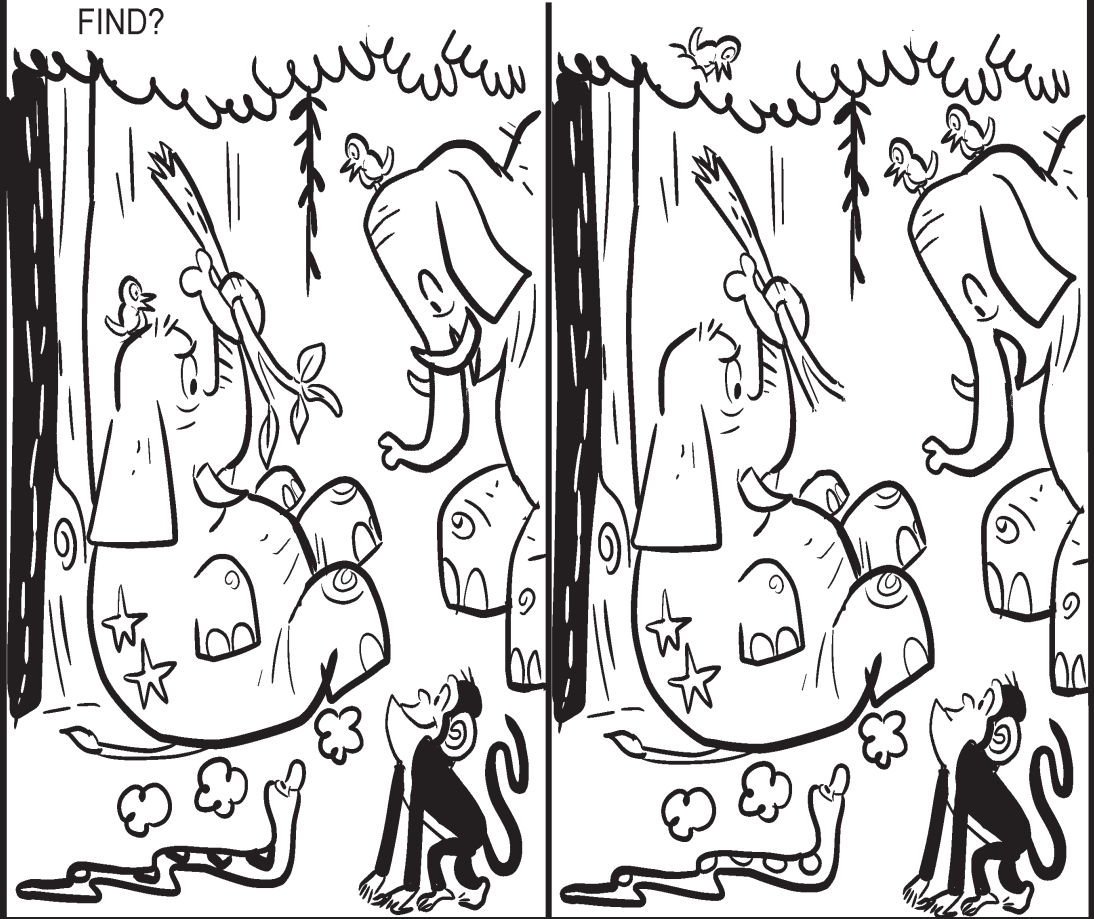
give to your great-great-grandchildren,” Dearth said. “We encourage photographs or other paper items, like poems or drawings.”

An engraved brass plaque with the port’s name, date of burying and opening instructions will be affixed to the capsule, which will be registered with the International Time Capsule Society at Oglethorpe University in Atlanta, Ga. It is to be opened on Sept. 14, 2113.

“Use your imagination in deciding what to submit, and please join us and enjoy cake and help us celebrate the port’s centennial on Sept. 14,” Dearth added.
