

"There is no paperwork to fill out, just come and eat a great lunch with a wonderful fruit and salad bar," said Sharon Haga, head of food services for the Bandon School District.

Hospital patient satisfaction survey is under way

Your opinion is enormously important.

That's the message of a new survey being taken of people utilizing the services of the Emergency Department at Southern Coos Hospital.

"We want to be sure that every patient's treatment needs are met and their experience in emergency is positive," said Charles Johnston, CEO of Southern Coos Hospital & Health Center.

As a result, the hospital has begun inviting patients to complete a survey before they leave the emergency room. The patients fill out the survey on a tablet-sized computer, answering 12 multiple-choice questions. A

staff member is available to assist if a person is unfamiliar with computers or seeks clarification on a question.

Questions include, among others, how long a person had to wait before being seen by a physician, how well they were treated by staff and attending physicians and how well their pain was controlled. Results are provided to an off-site service that tracks, tabulates and reports back. In addition, a member of hospital administration is alerted via email if one of the answers indicates follow-up is needed.

"If a person has a great experience, we want to hear that," Johnston said. "If the experience

was not so great, we want to hear that too and work to improve. Our patients' input will help us give the best care possible right here in our hometown emergency department."

The Emergency Department at Southern Coos is staffed 24/7 by physicians contracted through EmCare, the nation's leading physician ER management service. Each doctor on staff is skilled and experienced in emergency room patient care. Dr. Sam Richard, a physician with more than 30 years in family medicine and seven years of emergency room duty, is the Interim Site Medical Director for Southern Coos Hospital.

Fire season officially open

As the weather stays dry, the state of Oregon is gearing up to crack down on summer wildfires.

As of July 1, Coos, Curry and southern Douglas counties are under a declared fire season. The fire season declaration marks the implementation of land use restrictions on private, county, state and BLM lands within the Coos Forest Protective Association's jurisdiction.

The use of outside burn piles and burn barrels are prohibited through the end of the season. Cutting firewood requires an 8-ounce fire extinguisher and shovel. Power saws must be equipped with an approved screen.

The first major wildfire of the season flared up Sunday near Gardiner when a flame in logging slash burned 42 acres off Sparrow Park Road. The cause of the fire remains under investigation.
