Jury Duty scam circulating on South Coast

SOUTH COAST - The Coos and Curry County sheriff's offices are warning the public that another telephone scam is circulating in both counties and other areas of Oregon. A caller tells people that they have missed jury duty and that a warrant has been issued for their arrest. The caller identifies himself as

an officer and says the person receiving the call must put money on a card and call in the number on the card, or face being arrested and sent to jail immediately.

The Sheriff's Office reminds the public that any phone call where someone is asking for money and threatens you with arrest is a scam. Law enforcement

personnel would never call anyone to threaten them or ask for money. The calls may appear to come from a local area code but most likely are coming from out of the county or from criminals in prison.

Anyone who receives such a call should immediately report it to their local law enforcement agency.

Bronze sculptures, photographs at Bandon Library Art Gallery

BANDON – Bronze sculptures by Ken Ayers and photographs by Jan Cedras Ayers will be featured at the Bandon Library Art Gallery through April 30.

A photographer of wide-ranging interests, Jan Cedras Ayers began photographing her husband Ken's bronze sculptures to make a record of them, when she found herself enthralled by the way the light moved over them, the colors and reflections captured in their surfaces. She saw revealed a potential for making photographic studies of them as stand-alone works of abstract art. As she makes these explorations of composition and light, her photographs become

topographies of stunning depth and complexity.

Ken Ayers' sculptures begin as bits of kelp, stems, pieces of driftwood, slender, vine-wrapped trunks, bits of twine or cloth and become fantastical bronze flowers and plants from another world. These twisting, dancing creations may be made from a single element, or may incorporate several pieces from different sources bound together to create something unknown in nature, but which clearly reference the familiar, natural world. Their mysterious forms are studies in grace, often seeming almost airborne despite their weight.

Police warn of car break-ins, thefts

BANDON – Bandon Police are warning residents about a rash of car break-ins and urging locals to hide valuables.

There have been seven reports of car break-ins since Monday, March 6. In addition, police have responded to reports of stolen vehicles twice in the last two weeks.

All car break-ins usually have one thing in common, said Bandon Police Chief Bob Webb: There is something left in the vehicle worth stealing.

"Most thefts are crimes of opportunity that could be easily prevented by taking some preventative measures," Webb said.

The Bandon Police Department offers

some advice for area residents:

- Don't leave valuables (guns, GPS units, cell phones, loose change, packages, bags, etc) in your vehicle in plain sight; place all items out of sight before parking.
- Remove evidence of valuables such as GPS suction cups, mounting brackets and cell phone chargers.
- Try to park in a well lit area.
- Install and use an alarm system in your vehicle.
- Lock all of your vehicle's doors
- "Your cooperation in assisting the Bandon Police Department in protecting your property from theft and damage is greatly appreciated," Webb said.
