March library art show features fiber art, jewelry

BANDON – The Bandon Public Library March art show features Susan DeSalvatore's fiber art and Jane Ujhazi's stone necklaces.

With her hand-constructed fiber art, and using screen-printing, dyeing, painting, and burning, and design elements such as beads and colorful shredded cloth, DeSalvatore explores themes of grief, grace, mercy and the phases of life common to all. She incorporates language into some of the pieces, both single words and poems, and uses printed photographs to make a complex canvas on which to

express her ideas and reveal layers of meaning. Other pieces are collages made of torn bits of thread and cloth - abstract works that are brilliant celebrations of pure color and texture.

Jane Ujhazi's natural stone necklaces of silver, amber, turquoise and other semi-precious stones are contemporary, but happily acknowledge the past. A collector of antique and tribal beads from around the world, Ujhazi is inspired by the long tradition of human self-decoration, and evokes many different periods and lands with her designs. The show runs through March 30.

Curry County adopts mass notification system

CURRY COUNTY – As of March 1, Curry County and the city of Brookings are providing a new Mass Notification System to the citizens of Curry County.

This system, powered by EverBridge and nicknamed "Curry Alert," will provide Notifications to the citizens via regular telephone, VOIP (Internet) telephone, cell phone, email and text features.

Alerts to citizens via this source will be emergency or of significant information only, according to Don Kendall, Curry County emergency services coordinator.

The white and yellow telephone book pages have already been programmed into the system. Citizens and others can "opt-in" or subscribe themselves if their normal phone was not included in these pages, or the communication device of their choice was

not included.

To "opt-in," go to the Curry County Oregon web page (<http://www.co.curry.or.us>), scroll to the bottom of the front page and click on the "Curry Alert" button to create your own account and add your contact and location information into the system. If you need more information before subscribing, read the sign up, overview, and FAQ's at the top of this page.

The city of Brookings will soon provide an "opt-in" source also (<http://www.brookings.or.us/>).

You can stop receiving the alerts at any time by removing your contact information from your profile. All information you provide will be kept strictly confidential.

"Remember ... If we can't reach you, we can't alert you," Kendall said.

‘Agnes of God’ next Playhouse offering

BANDON – An intimate adult drama of mystery, murder, motherhood and madness describes the Bandon Playhouse’s next production, “Agnes of God,” which opens April 1 and runs weekends through April 17 at the Best Western motel in Bandon.

John Pielmeier’s story of “Agnes of God” unfolds through the memories of Dr. Martha Livingstone, the psychiatrist appointed by the court to determine the competency of a novice nun named Agnes to stand trial in the death of her newborn child. Mother Superior Miriam Ruth is determined to shield Agnes, who exudes a particular naïve innocence. The interaction of these three women forms the heart of the play.

Johnna Hickox plays the psychiatrist, Cathy Underdown plays Mother Superior and Cynthia Mohorko plays Agnes in this version directed by Playhouse president Bobbi Neason. The title is a pun on the Latin phrase *Agnus Dei* (Lamb of God).

Based on a true story, “Agnes of God” has enjoyed a revival among women’s groups, who believe it examines important ethical and spiritual issues that women must face. “Theater for thinkers” is how Neason describes the play’s underlying themes. The themes and meaning of “Agnes of God” emerge largely through the doctor’s private reflections and the interaction of

the characters and revolve around questions of faith and fulfillment, sanity and ecstasy, and reason and religion.

“The beauty of this play is that it asks fundamental questions and gives you space to answer them yourself,” Neason said.

This show represents a new direction for Bandon Playhouse for edgier, more serious productions with small casts that utilize a smaller venue.

That’s why the show will not be performed at the Sprague Theater, but at the Best Western conference room. The room will be transformed into a theater space, with lights and a minimal set. Refreshments will be available at intermission.

Neason, in order to give the audience background about the play, will offer a “preface” at 7 p.m. prior to each Saturday show, and a “talk back” for theater-goers to ask questions of the actors will be held following each Sunday production.

Show dates are April 1, 2 and 3; April 8, 9 and 10; and April 15, 16 and 17. Friday and Saturday shows are at 7:30 p.m. and Sunday matinees are at 2.
