Odd Fellows seek applicants for UN trip

BANDON – The United Nations Pilgrimage for Youth is an allexpenses-paid educational trip to visit the United Nations in New York as well as other sites in NYC, and historical sites along the East Coast, including Philadelphia, Washington D.C., Gettysburg and Ottawa, Canada. The Pilgrimage will be from Saturday, July 8, 2017 through July 18, 2017, with the send-off dinner at the state Odd Fellows Lodge in Portland being held on Friday, July 7, 2017.
