Candidate packets available

BANDON -- Mayor and City Council candidate packets for the Nov. 8 election are now available at City Hall. The seats that will be up for election or re-election include the mayor's position, currently occupied by Mary Schamehorn, and three city councilor positions, currently occupied by Claudine Hundhausen, Geri Procetto and Brian Vick. It is anticipated that all of the incumbents will be running for office again, according to Winkel. The mayor's term is for two years and the councilor terms are four years each, all beginning in January 2017. All positions are at-large and non-partisan. To run for office, an individual must be a

qualified elector who has resided in the City of Bandon during the 12 months immediately preceding the election.

The deadline for filing a completed petition, with no less than the required 25 signatures of qualified City of Bandon electors, is Aug. 30, 2016. However, all candidates must submit it far enough in advance of that deadline to allow sufficient time for the Bandon and the Coos County Elections Officials to complete the signature verification process. There are several mandatory steps in the filing process, including obtaining all of the necessary forms, providing the required information, meeting

the qualifications for elective office, securing written approval from the City Elections Official to circulate the prospective nominating petition and signature sheets before gathering any signatures, obtaining a sufficient number of valid signatures, and meeting the other filing requirements. All potential candidates must check with the City Elections Official (City Recorder Denise Russell) at City Hall or email drussell@cityofbandon.org regarding the requirements for running for mayor or city council in advance of circulating any petitions or collecting any signatures.

'Sitting is the New Smoking' seminar at library

BANDON -- Oregon State University Extension Family & Community Health will offer a free workshop on the health risks of sitting presents "Sitting is the New Smoking," a seminar on how sitting contributes to the development of chronic disease.

Sitting more than 5 hours a day is the health risk equivalent to smoking 1.25 packs of cigarettes a day. Dr James Levine, Director of the Mayo Clinic Obesity Solutions Initiative at Arizona State University, coined the phrase, "Sitting is the new smoking." According to his research, prolonged sitting increases your risk of premature death by 40 percent.
