‘Oregon My Home’ video to feature local musicians

SOUTH COAST – Musicians and singers from three counties in Oregon are collaborating on a project called “Oregon, My Home,” which was inspired by the beauty of the state and its people. The music video showcases a new orchestral and choral anthem by the same name, which was composed by Kristi Kelty of Coos Bay – ironically, only a few days before a fishing boat tragedy resulted in mens’ lives being lost at sea.

The music video will include notable musicians from Coos, Curry and Douglas counties. To date, the South Coast Community Choir, directed by John Harding, and the Oregon Mandolin Orchestra, directed by Brian Oberlin are on board, as well as Don “Doc” Slyter, an elder with the Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw tribes, who will be performing the intro for the piece on one of his handmade flutes. Guitarist Michael Gregory from Nashville is associate producer and lead

arranger for the music. Coos Bay’s master keyboard player Douglas Jones (The Young Bucs) produced the first project demo. Bandon’s Holly Sylvester and John Harding (of Sly & Friends) are working on an SATB for the chorus. Musicians Hege Bakken and Alayne Olmstead are among some of the notable fiddle players who will perform a Celtic segment of the piece.

“Once the South Coast Community Choir learns the piece we will outreach to other choirs and singers who would like to participate in this project. We need a large choir for this,” said Kelty, who has composed award-winning orchestral pieces in addition to the “California Anthem,” which has been performed by many choirs, most recently at the Shoreline Amphitheatre in Mountain View, Calif., by a choir of 650 singers.

‘Fertilize Your Mind’ garden seminar features Zoë Bradbury of Valley Flora Farm

COOS BAY – Registration forms are now available for the 15th annual “Fertilize Your Mind” garden seminar set for Saturday, March 26, on the campus of Southwestern Oregon Community College.

This year’s keynote speaker will be Zoë Bradbury, farmer and co-owner of Valley Flora Farm in Langlois. Bradbury’s presentation, “Regenerative Agriculture - Farm, Landscape, Community and Planet,” will share her experiences on their own farm, as well as broader, far-reaching concepts and issues in agriculture.

Following the keynote presentation will be three class sessions, each with a selection of four informative classes to choose from, presented by experienced and practical speakers. Some of the topics include “Backyard Chickens,” “Beekeeping 101-How to get your hive started,” “Spicing up your Garden-Herbs in the Garden,” “Landscaping with Native Plants” and “Moles, Voles, and Deer-IPM in a Big Way!” Local nurseries, landscape companies and other businesses will display goods and services in the lobby for perus-
