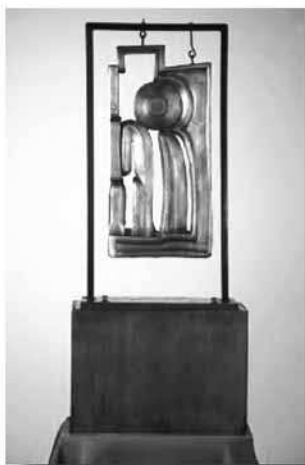

Museum displays works from its rental collection

COOS BAY – Through Feb. 13, Coos Art Museum will feature a special exhibition of works drawn from its Rental/Sales Gallery. Art from local and regional artists will be on view in the Clare Wehrle Community Gallery. Featured artworks will include a variety of styles, media, and sizes.

The artworks will be available for immediate sale or may be rented by Coos Art Museum members. This is a great opportunity to learn about the Rental/Sales Gallery and participating artists. It is also a perfect occasion to support both the Museum and

Library Art Show features paintings, clay figures

BANDON – Ken Michaelson's paintings are displayed in the hall and Ginny Gibson's clay figures are on display in the glass cases of the Bandon Library Art Gallery for the month of January.

In addition, in an effort to meet medical expenses, some of Michaelson's original paintings and prints will be available for purchase at the reception.

The exquisitely detailed, beautifully realized birds painted in gouache by Michaelson are the works of a master, according to organizers. The iridescent sheen of a mallard's head, or the light in a

golden eye are brought to vivid life in these paintings. Also on display are Michaelson's rarer, equally rich oil paintings of scenes of the natural world.

In the cases, Gibson's small clay figures make delightful tableaux of everyday life: the pleasures of reading outdoors, visiting with a friend, a beloved dog's companionship. These little scenes crystallize the emotion of such familiar moments, while avoiding sentimentality or kitsch. Her handmade tiles and other objects will accompany the figures.
