

Museum to honor veterans with special program Nov. 14

BANDON – The Bandon Historical Society will be honoring veterans with a special program from 11 a.m.-3 p.m. on Nov. 14, the Saturday after Veterans Day.

Admission to the museum will be free all day during regular open hours from 10 a.m.-4 p.m.

The exhibit will feature items from some personal military collections as well as the museum's own collection of military uniforms and artifacts. Museum volunteer Rick Hinojosa is spearheading the event.

Military vehicles will be on display in the museum parking lot. Sergeant Mann of the Coos Bay unit of the Oregon National Guard is bringing a military vehicle and items from the Coos Bay armory. Jim Shipp from Myrtle Point VFW is bringing a collection of vehicles from WW2, Korean War and Vietnam eras.

John Hartman, who has been teaching a fall course on the Civil War at Southwestern Oregon Community College, will share items from his collection of Civil War artifacts. Hinojosa, a Vietnam War veteran, will display WWII items as well as a collection of Japanese swords.

Other collectors will have items on display and the museum will display additional items related to the military service of local veterans.

The free program is open to the public. Area veterans are especially encouraged to attend and share their stories with the museum community.

The Bandon Historical Museum is located at the corner of U.S. Highway 101 and Fillmore Avenue.



SWOCC offers piano concert and master classs

COOS BAY – The music department at Southwestern Oregon Community College announces a piano concert and master class, presented by Peter Gach, to be held from 3:30-5 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 4, in Sunset Hall on the Coos Bay campus.

The concert is free and open to the public and will run until 4:15 p.m. After the concert the master class will commence. No registration is necessary.

Gach is a pianist of wide-ranging musical interests. He holds advanced degrees in

music from the University of Arizona and Indiana University, and completed post-graduate studies at the Warsaw Conservatory in Poland. He studied there with the late Jan Ekier, editor of the Urtext Edition of the Complete Works of Chopin. A proponent of new music for the piano, he has premiered works by numerous composers. He is professor emeritus at Palomar College, where he served as both chairman of the performing arts department and artist in residence on piano.

Health insurance assistance offered

BANDON – This fall, residents of south Coos and north Curry counties can find assistance with health insurance enrollment closer to home.

Coast Community Health Center staff now includes Community Health Outreach Workers and enrollment assisters, all of whom are trained to provide free, confidential information about public health insurance coverage for adults and children.

Schedule information and enrollment sessions are at Coast Community Health Center in Bandon, 541-347-2529; or at the new outreach office in Port Orford, 541-332-1114. Learn more at coastcommunityhealth.org/insurance-enrollment-assistance.

Open enrollment is Nov. 1, 2015 to Jan. 31, 2016. Oregonians can enroll in private market plans, also called Qualified Health Plans, and find out if they are eligible for financial assistance to make their coverage more affordable. Open enrollment for 2016 coverage closes Jan. 31 for those who do not qualify for Medicaid/CHIP, or choose to enroll in private or employer insurance policies.

The Oregon Health Plan is the state's Medicaid/CHIP program for low-income residents from all walks of life, including adults and children. OHP benefits include primary care visits, mental health care, addiction treatment, dental care and approved prescriptions. OHP enrollment is open year-round.

Application assisters with Coast Community Health Center are trained to help individuals and families apply for coverage, or check their eligibility and application status. They can also assist with OHP renewals.

Those who qualify for OHP are required to renew their benefits at least once every 12 months. Application assisters at Coast Community Health Center encourage OHP members to watch their mail and complete any renewal paperwork they receive throughout the year. Those who have questions about correspondence regarding their OHP coverage are welcome to contact an application assister for help.

Intriguing stories abound in Oregon State Archives

SALEM – In celebration Archives of American Month in October, the Oregon State Archives has opened a new exhibit, "I Found it in the Archives." Each exhibit panel depicts a bizarre, curious, nefarious, whimsical, salacious or scandalous story extracted from the Archives holdings. The exhibit, located in the State Archives building gallery, is a collaborative effort by State Archives researchers. volunteers. student interns and staff who have shared their stories of discovery. These stories highlight the diversity of records held at the State Archives, demonstrate the personal value of each research project, and will help encourage further research on the state's oneof-a-kind primary records.

The exhibit includes stories depicting a famous Southern Oregon train rob-

bery by the D'Autremont brothers, the 1918-1919 Influenza Pandemic that claimed the life of a legislator, and a precedent-setting decision where a murder conviction was brought forth without a body.

The exhibit will be on display through the end of the year and the Archives staff invites the public to not only view the exhibit but to

come in and do their own research. Oregonians who find a story are encouraged to share their experience with the Archives staff for inclusion in future "I Found it in the Archives!" exhibits.

The State Archives are located at 800 Summer Street NE in Salem. Normal operating hours are 8 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Friday.
