Repair work scheduled for Highway 101 south this summer

BANDON – The Oregon Department of Transportation will resurface a five mile section of U.S. Highway 101 south of Bandon this summer.

According to ODOT public affairs officer Dan Latham, the project area will extend from Johnson Creek (milepost 275.7) to McTimmons Lane (milepost 280.5). At the north end of the work zone, between Johnson Creek and Beach Loop Road, the contractor will grind out two inches of existing pavement and replace it with new asphalt. South of Beach Loop Road, where the road is more

damaged, the contractor will repair areas that are cracking and pave four inches of new asphalt over the existing road surface.

Due to high traffic volumes in this area, most paving will be scheduled at night. From 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., traffic will be reduced to a single lane through the work zone and pilot cars will provide traffic control. Because there are more than 100 driveways along this stretch of highway, there is a danger that drivers leaving home could turn into oncoming traffic, causing a head-on collision. Therefore, when the highway is limited to a single lane at night, residents should wait in their driveways for a pilot car before turning onto the highway. ODOT will post signs at the end of each driveway in the work zone and flaggers will provide traffic control at each intersection.

While some construction will take place in June, most of the nighttime paving work is scheduled for July and August. Motorists can also expect intermittent day-time lane closures.

Utilities report: South Jetty water line now looped

BANDON - For those of you who have been wondering what was going on along Madison Avenue from Ocean Drive down to the South Jetty over the past several weeks, the water department was completing the installation of a recirculating loop for water that goes to the South Jetty. This ensures that water can flow into the area even if the water line coming down Jetty Road should break. It also is important to have a good strong flow from the fire hydrants when there is a fire and the looped line makes sure that will always happen. It also ensures that the water that is delivered to the South Jetty has the proper amount of chlorine to prevent bacterial

growth in those water lines that are used infrequently. When water stands in pipes, chlorine leaves the system and leads to the risk of bacterial growth. Most of the water lines in Bandon are looped and the South Jetty is one of the last to be completed.

For the next several months, a Utilities Commission member will be available from 10 to 11 a.m. on Saturday mornings at Brewed Awakenings to answer questions and explain why the commission recommended a \$10 increase in the base rate for residential customers and a \$20 increase in the commercial base rate. Everyone is encouraged to come by and ask questions.
