

New readers theater group to present shipwreck tale

BANDON - "I'm not sure how to say this tactfully, so I'll just be direct. You, Ann Saunders, are a dead woman. For well over a hundred years. Now, I'm not making any judgments ..."

A movie producer spars with the ghost of a shipwreck survivor over how to tell her story in the original tragicomedy, "The Sufferings of Ann Saunders." A staged reading of the play will be performed by Bandon's new readers theater group, The Gaels, on April 21, 22, and 23, at the Bandon Public Library

"Ann Saunders really existed, surviving a horrific shipwreck and much worse," said playwright Neal Davis. "Having her ordeal distorted by Hollywood allowed me to share her story honestly but with humor, while also debating truth, faith and whether we own our own history."

This is the group's first production.

"We created The Gaels as a vehicle to bring new and lesser-known plays to our community," said Davis. "The words are performed, not simply read, by experienced actors. For \$5, you get the drama and the talent, just without the theater extras."

The cast includes Corrie Gant, Donald Zealand and Amy Moss Strong, who also

performed together in the Bandon Playhouse staged reading "I Was Really Very Hungry." Mike Dempsey, who starred in the sold-out "Santaland Diaries" this past December, directs, and Richard Robinett will introduce each performance. Davis has authored several shows in Bandon, including the musical "Bethlehem Road," a Helen Keller shadow-theater production for the Bandon Lions, and the comedy "Web Browsers."

The Gaels anticipate four staged readings a year, focusing on powerful but rarely seen works. They welcome submissions from local writers.

"It's expensive to put on plays, which is why most go un-produced," said Davis. "It's especially tough for local or first-time writers. Staged readings create an opportunity for artists and audiences that otherwise wouldn't occur."
