Blessing of the Fleet on Saturday

The Port of Bandon invites the community and visitors to the annual Blessing of the Fleet at 1 p.m., today, in the boat launch parking lot at the Fishermen's Memorial.

Local clergy will officiate the service, bagpiper Richard Lang will perform and the U.S. Coast Guard will then lay flowers on the Coquille River bar in conjunction with Bandon's VFW Post 3440, which will provide a gun salute on the South Jetty.

Loved ones who have been lost at sea and those in the military who gave their lives for the country will be honored. A blessing for those men and women currently serving and veterans who have returned from war or served in any capacity is planned as well. The blessing also will include those who fish the seas and those who make their livings commercial fishing. Port of Bandon General Manager Gina Dearth asks those interested to call the port to include in the service the name of a loved one who died in a water-related accident.

Flowers or wreaths can be brought to the service. They will be delivered to the Coast Guard vessel for distribution on the bar. Port officials ask that the flower arrangements contain no plastics, wire, cellophane, etc. Cotton string for binding is recommended.

This event coincides with the port's annual free Marine Swap Meet from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the boardwalk, and the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary's vessel safety inspections from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the port's parking lot west of the boat launch. The vessel safety check also is available by appointment.

Bandon Time Capsule Seeks Submissions

THE PORT of Bandon is accepting items to put in the 100-year time capsule it plans to bury on Saturday, Sept. 14, as part of its centennial celebration.

Submissions will be accepted through July 31 and the container will be buried near the port offices in the historic Coquille River Lifesaving Station, 390 First Street S.W.

A reception for the public, port friends and partners is being planned to coincide with the interment of the stainless steel capsule, which has a capacity of about 2 cubic feet.

Gina Dearth, port general manager, explained that before the box is welded shut, it will be purged with dry argon gas to help prevent oxidation or acidic reaction within the contents.

"We're told this is a specialized process that's used in the food, chemical, cryogenic and pharmaceutical industries," she said. "According to the manufacturer, the contents of our capsule will last virtually forever."

Public submissions, which must be limited in size due to the container's capacity, should be intended to inform people in 2113 about Bandon's culture in 2013.

"Or it could be advice or a small heirloom that you wish you could give to your great-great-grandchildren," Dearth said. "We encourage photographs or other paper items, like poems or drawings."

An engraved brass plaque with the port's name, date of burying and opening instructions will be affixed to the capsule, which will be registered with the International Time Capsule Society at Oglethorpe University in Atlanta, Ga. It is to be opened on Sept. 14, 2113.

"Use your imagination in deciding what to submit, and please join us and enjoy cake and help us celebrate the port's centennial on Sept. 14," Dearth added.
