



Bandon historical hike to be held Sunday

BANDON – Join archaeologist and historian Reg Pullen for a 4-mile walking tour of Bandon on Sunday, Aug. 7, sponsored by the South Coast Striders. Meet at 9 a.m. in the public parking lot in Old Town Bandon at the corner of Second St. SE and Alabama Ave.

Pullen will share all the local lore and colorful history of Bandon while touring various historical points of interest. The total hike is 4 miles, rated moderate, with some sand walking involved, and should last 2.5-3 hours. The first part of the walk will take place in Old Town Bandon, and those who do not wish to participate in the longer beach walk can end their walk there. Dress appropriately for the weather. A windbreaker with a hood is recommended for the beach section. Walking sticks might be helpful for the beginning of the beach walk. Bring water. Those participating might want to pack a lunch to each on the Bandon Boardwalk, or are invited to each at one of Bandon's many fine lunch spots. After the hike, those with an interest in Bandon's history are encouraged to stop by the Bandon Historical Society Museum at U.S. Highway 101 and Fillmore Ave., which is open until 4 p.m. Sunday.

Meet & Greet the Artist to feature Susan Lehman

BANDON – Susan Lehman, local collage artist, will be at Second Street Gallery from 11 a.m.-4 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 6, as part of the Meet & Greet the Artist summer program.

Lehman will be demonstrating her "embedded collage" technique where she uses acrylic gels and mediums to glue down pieces of kimono silk scraps, lace, textured handmade paper and other bits and pieces before she begins painting.

Lehman recently won the first prize at the Northwest Collage Society Summer Exhibition in Seattle as well as the first place award in small works at the Art by the Sea Gallery here in Bandon.
