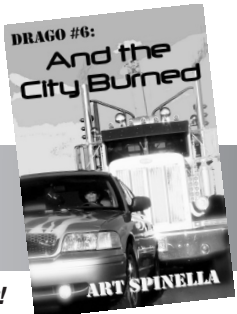

Get set, Bandon, for the first monthly Alive After Five Art Walk from 5 to 8 p.m. Friday, June 21. Bandon's galleries are joining up with participating Bandon merchants to welcome both residents and tourists to explore all that the community has to offer.

The Greater Bandon Association's events and promotions committee views this as another opportunity for organizations in Bandon to collaborate their activities and at the same time create another fun experience for young and old alike.

GBA coordinator Harv Schubothe has been working with a group of artists and galleries to introduce an art walk to Bandon. We see a late Friday afternoon start time as perfect for this activity as tourists are just arriving for the weekend and looking for things to do while many local people are winding down their work week and are ready to relax."
