Tidepooling workshop offered in Gold Beach

GOLD BEACH – Sea shells are beautiful, with their coils and spines, colors and shapes. Learn about mollusks and the other fascinating organisms you will find in southern Oregon’s tide pools in a workshop offered by Southwestern Oregon Community College.

In this workshop, instructor Nancy Treneman introduces marine snails, sea slugs, and chitons. Friday night topics cover many aspects of molluscan biology: the diversity of body plans, reproduction, feeding, and connections in the ecosystem. Saturday morning is a field trip into the

rocky intertidal area to observe local species. The field trip is early, but it will be “so worth it,” Treneman said. Dress warmly and wear rubber boots.

The lecture is scheduled for 6-8:30 p.m. Friday, May 20, at Southwestern’s Gold Beach Center (on the fairgrounds). The next morning, Saturday, May 21, the class will leave the Gold Beach Center at 5:30 a.m. to take advantage of the low tide, returning from the field trip around 9 a.m. Cost of the workshop is \$35. Lyme disease awareness topic of talk

LANGLOIS – Due to the increased cases of Lyme disease and the disabling autoimmune disease associated with Lyme, Oregon Lyme Disease Network of Bend is coming to the South Coast to promote Lyme awareness in the general community and among medical professionals.

Sponsored by the Langlois and Port Orford public libraries, Theresa Denham, President of OLDN, will present a “Tick Talk,” an educational seminar on Lyme Disease, at 7 p.m. Friday, May 20, at the Langlois Public Library.

Medical professionals are invited by Denham to attend a brown bag lunch at noon on Friday, May 20, at the Langlois Public Library to participate in a discussion of the currently accepted AHRQ NGC guidelines on Lyme and tick-borne dis-

ease. Diagnostic options for the practitioner will be addressed, along with a question-and-answer session on Lyme disease. Oregon Governor Kate Brown has proclaimed the month of May to be “Lyme and Tick-borne Diseases Awareness Month” to increase knowledge among Oregon’s citizens who work and recreate in the outdoors during tick season. The proclamation recognizes the Oregon Lyme Disease Network’s advocacy for the alarming incidence of patients seeking support. Several support groups are operating in the state and the OLDN hopes to assist with the creation of one on the South Coast.
