Open enrollment assistance available for young adults

BANDON – College students and independent young adults can take advantage of cost-saving health insurance options. Open enrollment for 2017 health insurance policies ends Jan. 31.

Those 18 years and older who aren't covered by parent or employer insurance can learn more about Oregon policies and get help shopping the health insurance marketplace with enrollment assisters at Coast Community Health Center. The service is free and confidential.

Many are unsure how the federal insurance marketplace can help them access health care services more affordably, according to enrollment and outreach manager Lennae Wright. Here are a few of the com-

monly asked questions and answers Wright and health center staff discuss:

How does enrolling through the marketplace save me money? The marketplace is an online tool to help you apply for health insurance coverage. The marketplace represents participating insurance companies for your region so that you can easily compare a variety of plans side by side.

Applying through the marketplace will give you the opportunity to see if you qualify for the Oregon Health Plan, or for tax credits to offset the monthly cost of your insurance premium payment.

What if I choose not to enroll in a health insurance policy and pay cash for health care services?

The Affordable Care Act works for the public by preventing insurance companies from discriminating on coverage based on medical needs. The law also encourages more people to get coverage by offering tax breaks for those who enroll. Those who choose not to enroll in health care coverage will risk penalty fees in conjunction with their tax filing. If anyone is concerned about costs associated with the marketplace, Coast Community Health Center staff are prepared to answer questions.

How do I make an enrollment appointment? Call Health Center staff Monday through Friday, in Bandon, 541-347-2529, or in Port Orford, 541-332-1114. Learn more at coast-communityhealth.org.
