Friday, July 26: Owls of Oregon, 7-8:30 p.m.

Learn about the unique features of local owls, how recorded calls are used to locate owls and hopefully catch a glimpse of one at New River.

# July library art features photography, buttons

The July art display at the Bandon Public Library features the photography of Susan Tree in the library's hallway gallery and "A Potpourri of Buttons" in the glass cases. A talk by well-known button collector Jocelyn Howells will be held at noon, July 20, followed by a button sale from 1-3 p.m.

"I like looking at life especially in nature, seeing a world changing, moving, living, dying," Tree said. "Photography to me is like taking a part of nature and looking at it more deeply, focusing in on certain aspects you might not see when looking at the whole of it. A picture should draw you in, make you look just a little closer. Seeing our fragile ecosystems on the brink of changes pushes me to want to share the beauty of nature through my photos and tell a story about the world we live in. I also hope with these photos to make people aware of how special our planet is and that we really do need to take care.

The button display, hosted by the South Coast Button Club, will include sewing buttons from the Civil War era to modern times. The display will include buttons made from various types of metals, wood, celluloid, synthetic polymers, ivory and shell.

"While many of us remember the joy and fascination of sorting through our grandmother's button box, few of our grandmothers saved buttons like the ones you will see on display at the Bandon library during the month of July," said a member.

The South Coast Button Club generally meets monthly on a Saturday at the Bandon library. It is one of the

newest button collecting clubs in Oregon and began three years ago after a local collector hosted an educational presentation on collecting and preserving these "miniature works of art."

Collecting interesting buttons was among the top three national hobbies in the 1940s and 1950s. Today, the tradition continues on an international scale. The daily listings on eBay for vintage and antique sewing buttons number more than 30,000. The National Button Society currently enjoys more than 25,000 members, while the Oregon State Button Society, founded in 1948, has around 300 members.

In conjunction with the library display, the South Coast Button Club will host Jocelyn Howells, former Oregon State Button Society President and a nationally known author, button collector and educator. Howells has written two books on collecting antique and vintage buttons.

Howells will be featured at noon Saturday, July 20, in the Sprague Room of the library with a talk titled, "The Wonderful and Surprising World of Bakelite in Buttons." Following Howells' presentation, members of the South Coast Button Club and the Oregon State Button Society will be available for questions and discussion. Additionally, Howells will be offering antique and vintage buttons for sale from 1 to 3 p.m. All are welcome.

The library is located at 1204 11th St. S.W. in City Park and the displays will be up through July 31.


