BANDON – Birders in Coos County should mark their calendars for the annual membership meeting of their local National Audubon Society chapter. The Cape Arago Audubon Society will be meeting at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 12, at The Barn, 1200 11th St. SW in Bandon. This meeting is open to the public and all those wishing to get involved in birding activities in the area are encouraged to attend.

Birding activities for the coming year will be discussed. This includes monthly field trips to locations throughout Coos and Curry counties as well as monthly programs on issues and topics of interest to birders. Details on planned National Audubon activities will also be outlined including Christmas bird counts, North American migration counts and backyard

bird counts.

Highlighting the evening will be feature speaker Joe Metzler presenting, “Backpacking in the Elliott State Forest.” Keeping the Elliott in public ownership has been one of the primary goals of the Oregon Audubon Council in 2016.

'Hey Loretta' musical tribute at Sprague this weekend

BANDON – A talented group of Oregon musicians paying musical tribute to Loretta Lynn will tour the Oregon coast this fall and will perform on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, Oct. 7, 8 and 9, at Bandon's Sprague Community Theater, 1202 11th St. SW in City Park.

Fronted by the popular Portland folk-country songstress Mary Rondthaler, the five-piece band will perform a 90-minute show featuring the songs of country music legend Loretta Lynn. Also known as the Coal Miner's Daughter, Loretta wrote many of her own songs and has been dubbed the Queen of Country Music throughout her five-decade career. In 1972, she was the first woman to be named Entertainer of the Year by the Country Music Association.

The band features three graduates of Oregon State University who studied music under professor Neil Grandstaff,

who is widely known for his life-long contribution to music performance and education. They are Justin Schepige on bass, Tommy Brownson on drums and Erik Crew on lead guitar. Joining them on pedal steel guitar will be former Nashville professional musician Gary Thorsen, who has backed up many country music greats, most notably Tanya Tucker. Thorsen is locally known for his inspiring playing in the musical show "Who Is Going to Fill Their Shoes" and with the Opry West in North Bend at The Little Theater by The Bay.

The entourage is schedule to perform at several of the Oregon Coast's most endearing theaters. All Sunday shows will be a 2 p.m. matinee and other dates are 7 p.m. evening shows. Tickets are \$15 in advance and \$18 at the door and available at Bandon Ace Hardware, Bandon Mercantile and at www.hey-loretta.com/tickets.

Annual hospital flu clinic on Oct. 12

BANDON – The Southern Coos Hospital & Health Center will offer free flu shots at its annual Flu Shot Clinic beginning at 7 a.m. Wednesday, Oct. 12. SCHHC medical staff will administer the shots at the Bandon City Park (Note new location). The location will be clearly marked. Those wishing to receive flu shots are encouraged to drive up and remain in their cars and medical staff will assist. There is no charge for flu shots. Donations are encouraged.

The 2016 SCHHC Flu Shot Clinic is supported by the Southern Coos Hospital Auxiliary and the Southern Coos Health Foundation. In addition, the event is supported by proceeds from the recent Cycle Oregon event that stopped in Bandon. Over 40 volunteers from the Southern Coos Health District

volunteered to serve dinner to cyclists stopping in Bandon on Sept. 12. The Southern Coos Health District received funds for its volunteer efforts at Cycle Oregon.

The annual SCHHC Flu Shot Clinic is a popular service and many residents of Bandon have participated in the past. On average, SCHHC serves about 500 citizens with flu shots. According to the Centers for Disease Control, vaccination against the flu is one of the most important methods to prevent the spread of the influenza virus. Thus, the CDC recommends yearly flu shots. The flu vaccination can reduce flu illnesses, doctors' visits, missed work and school due to flu, as well as prevent flu-related hospitalizations and deaths.
