Bandon Public Library hosting Food for Fines

BANDON – The Bandon Public Library will again be hosting Food For Fines June 14-18.

Support the library as it collect food for the local Bandon Good Neighbors Food Bank. For each item of food that patrons bring to the library, fines will be reduced by \$1. Not acceptable are fresh, frozen or refrigerated items.

Items accepted include 6 ounce or larger nuts, canned fish and meats; 8 ounce or larger peanut butter, dried beans, powdered milk; 13 ounce or larger canned fruits/veg-

etables, chili, soup, canned beans, pasta sauces; 20 ounce or larger hot and cold cereals, packaged pastas (no ramen), crackers, cooking oil; 5-pound bags of sugar, flour and rice.

No expired or damaged items will be accepted.

“Help your community and clear up your fines,” said library director Roslyn McGarva. “Food cannot be accepted for lost or damaged items. Get ready for summer reading!”

Summer work on Highway 101 has begun

BROOKINGS – Bridge work will limit U.S. Highway 101 to a single lane of traffic at two locations in Curry County this summer.

Primary contractor Hamilton Construction of Springfield has begun concrete repairs and rail replacement on Reinhart Creek Bridge (milepost 311.4) and Thomas Creek Bridge (milepost 347.8). Reinhart Creek is located about 10 miles south of Port Orford and Thomas

Creek is about eight miles north of Brookings.

Construction will require lane closures from early June to early October, and a temporary traffic signal will be used at both bridges. Flaggers will provide additional traffic control as needed.

ODOT will briefly suspend work during two popular tourist events. All lanes on both bridges will be open July 28-31 for the Cape Blanco Country Music Festival and Sept.

13-14 for Cycle Oregon’s tour of the South Coast.
