

Proposed Action Plan for Pima Community College District (PCCD) Board of Trustees

- ACCT review of PCCD Board policies
 - ACCT will conduct a thorough review of current PCCD board policies. This review will examine standing policies for completeness, up-to-datedness, and appropriateness.
 - The result of this review will be presented to the board and chancellor in a report and discussed at a board retreat. Further, another product of this review will be the development of a Code of Ethics.
- In consultation with the board and chancellor, ACCT will construct an appropriate chancellor evaluation process.
- ACCT will lead a retreat for the PCCD Board of Trustees and Chancellor Lambert to discuss the following topics:
 - Review presidential evaluation process and board self-assessment process
 - Administer and review board self-assessment (immediately and after one year for follow-up)
 - Give guidance on executive limitations
 - Offer recommendations on how to engage with the public/surrounding community
 - Examination of mission
 - Does the current mission reflect the practices of the board?
 - What changes
 - Public notice
 - What is the current formal procedure for public notice?
 - Grievance role of the board
 - Who is responsible for last appeal?
 - Sexual harassment and grievance policy
 - What is the current policy?
 - In what ways does it need to be improved?
 - o Procurement
 - What is the official procurement policy?
 - Shared governance
