**For recovery and positive proof
of Frank (Frankie) Patane's remains.**

Please help us find him. My brother Frank Patane has been missing since Aug. 11, 2011.

He is 5 feet 10 inches tall weighing 165 pounds. He was wearing a red baseball cap and carrying a walking stick. He often carried two small water bottles stuffed into the front pockets of his pants. He was wearing hiking shoes. He could have been wearing prescription sun glasses and perhaps an old wrist watch.

The 94 trailhead log-in sheet at Sheep's Crossing at Mt. Baldy, shows he checked in early on the morning of Aug. 11 to begin his hike but no indication he ever signed out.

The storms were severe, and we fear he got disoriented and succumbed to the conditions.

My family and I want to thank everyone who helped in the search for Frank last summer and into the fall. With the coming of autumn, it may be easier to see some signs of him or his belongings. We are hopeful that we may be fortunate enough to recover him.
