

THREE OF QUARTET BOUND OVER FOR DEADLY ASSAULT

Sidiaco Guerrero Only Member
of Party Which Engaged in
Knife Battle Last Sunday to
be Released Yesterday.

Following a preliminary hearing before Justice of the Peace Jose E. Romero at the court house in Old Albuquerque yesterday afternoon, Sidiaco Guerrero was released from further custody. The other three members of the quartet who engaged in a knife battle Sunday afternoon near the Swastika saloon, on the saw mill road, Juan Calderon, Miguel Sedillo and Celso Sedillo, were bound over to the grand jury in the sum of \$500 each. The charge was assault with intent to kill.

The four tried pretty successfully, it is said, to carve each other up in the fight, and Miguel Sedillo was so badly hurt that his life was despaired for a time. There were no witnesses except the four men themselves.

The hearing took on considerable importance and the court stenographer, Harry P. Owen, was called upon to take a record of the proceedings. B. Ruppe, official court interpreter, officiated as translator.

All the men but Guerrero sustained severe cuts and bruises in the fight and will bear the resultant scars for life.
