SALOON KEEPER IS BOUND OVER TO GRAND JURY

Sario Gonzales Held to Tribunal for Alleged Sale of Liquor to Fighting Quartet on Sunday Last.

Because it was alleged that he was guilty of selling liquor last Sunday, Sario Gonzales, proprietor of the Swastika saloon, on the saw-mill road, was yesterday bound over to the grand jury by Justice of the Peace Jose E. Romero.

It was claimed that Celso and Miguel Sedillo and Juan Calderon and Sidiaco Guerrero, who attempted last Sunday to carve each other up, and succeeded indifferently well, got the liquor which caused their drunken brawl from Gonzalez and that their fight started in his place. All four are in jail and although Miguel Sedillo was badly slashed across the throat, and for a time his life was despaired of, all will be well enough to have trials at the fall session of the district court. They have not yet had preliminary hearings..
