

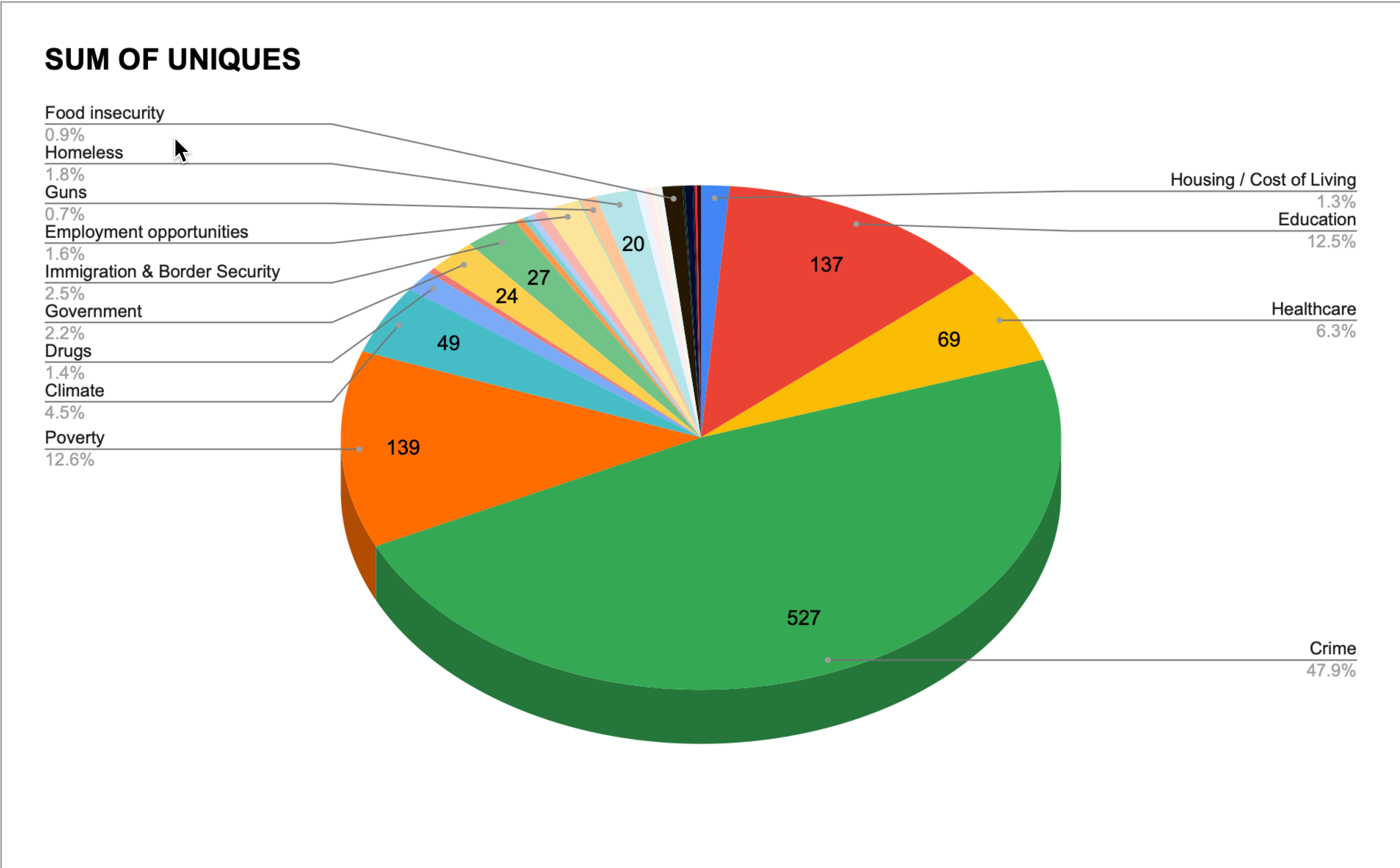

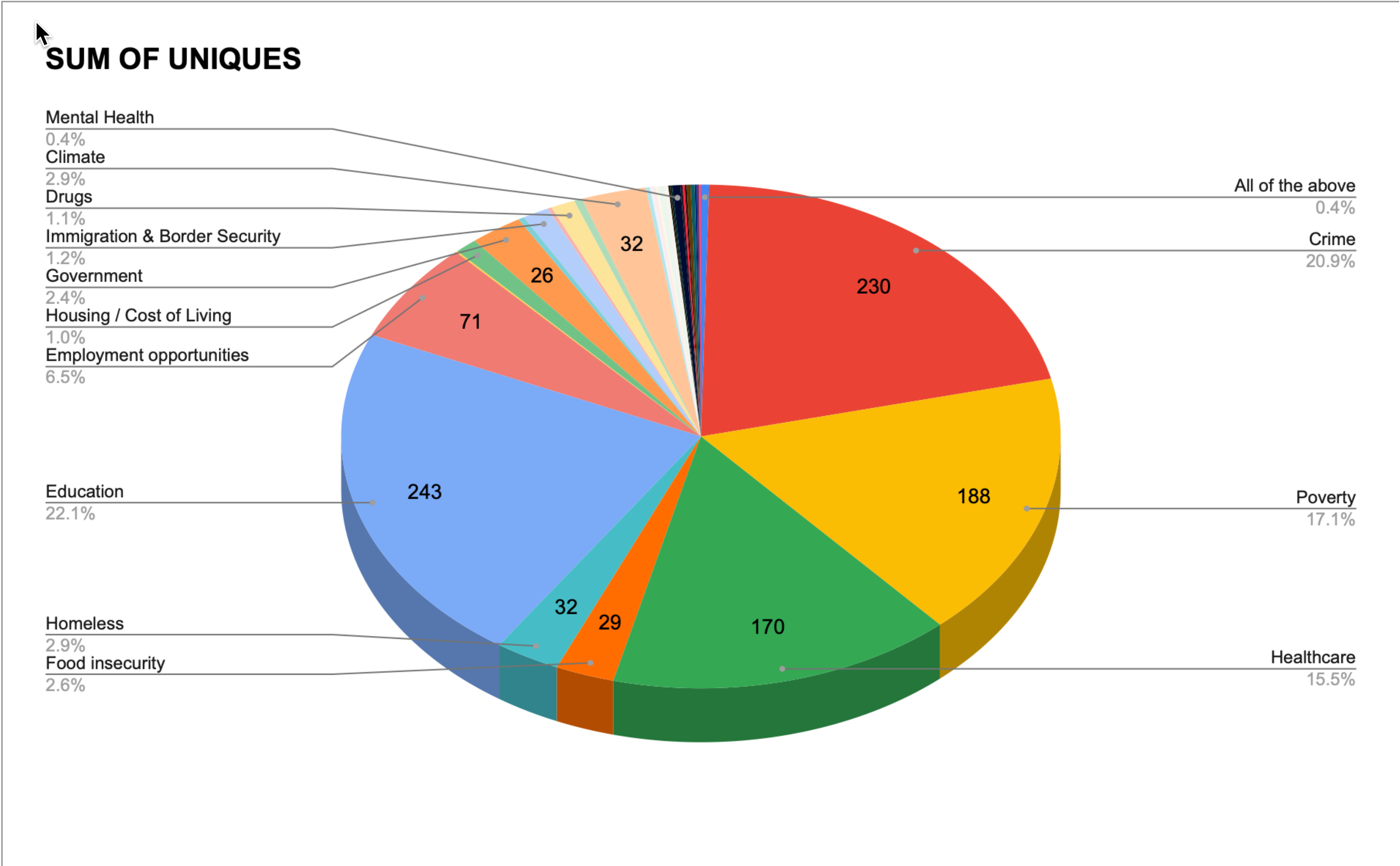

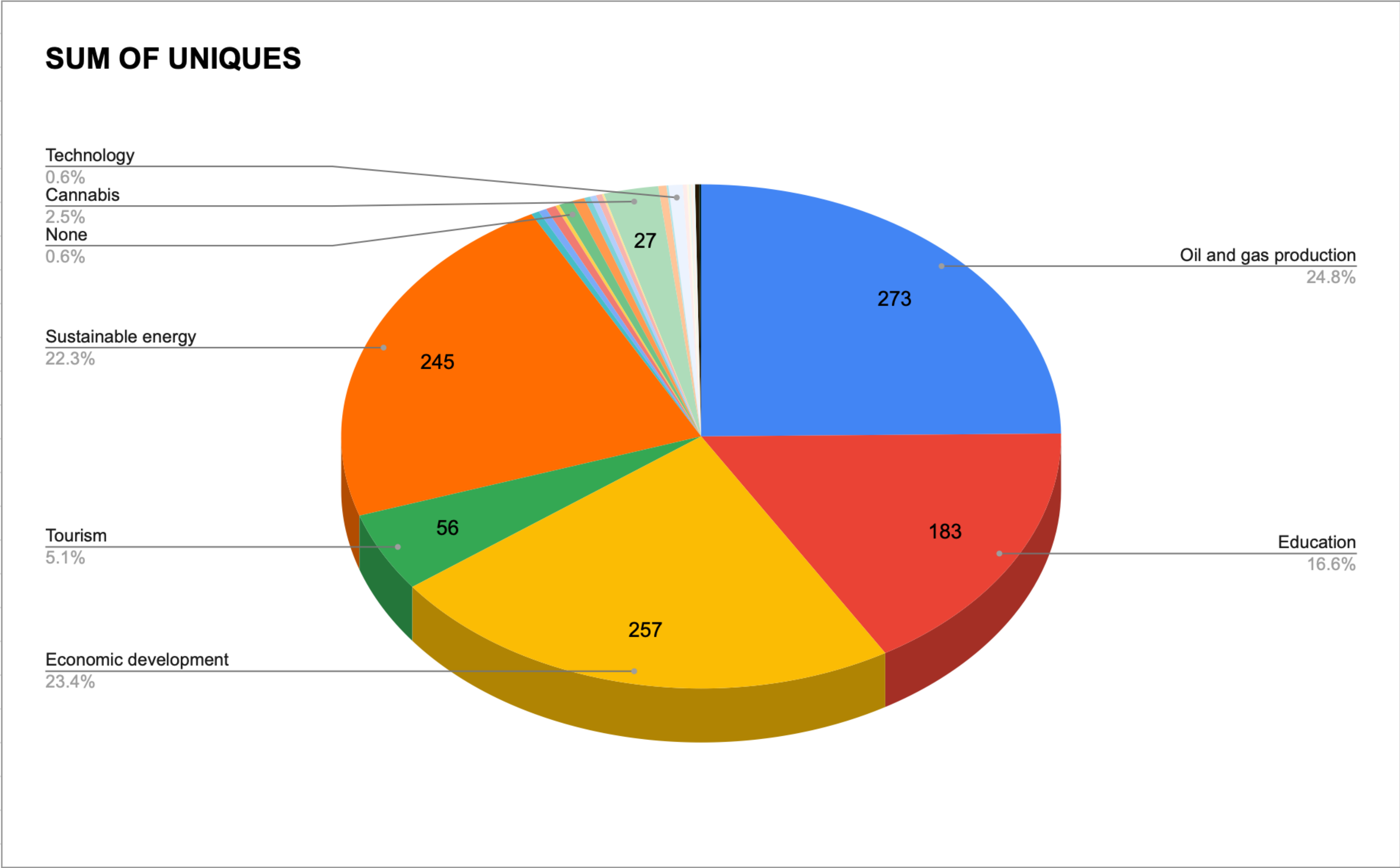
Question 1:

Of the issues facing New Mexicans, which do you think is the SECOND MOST IMPORTANT?

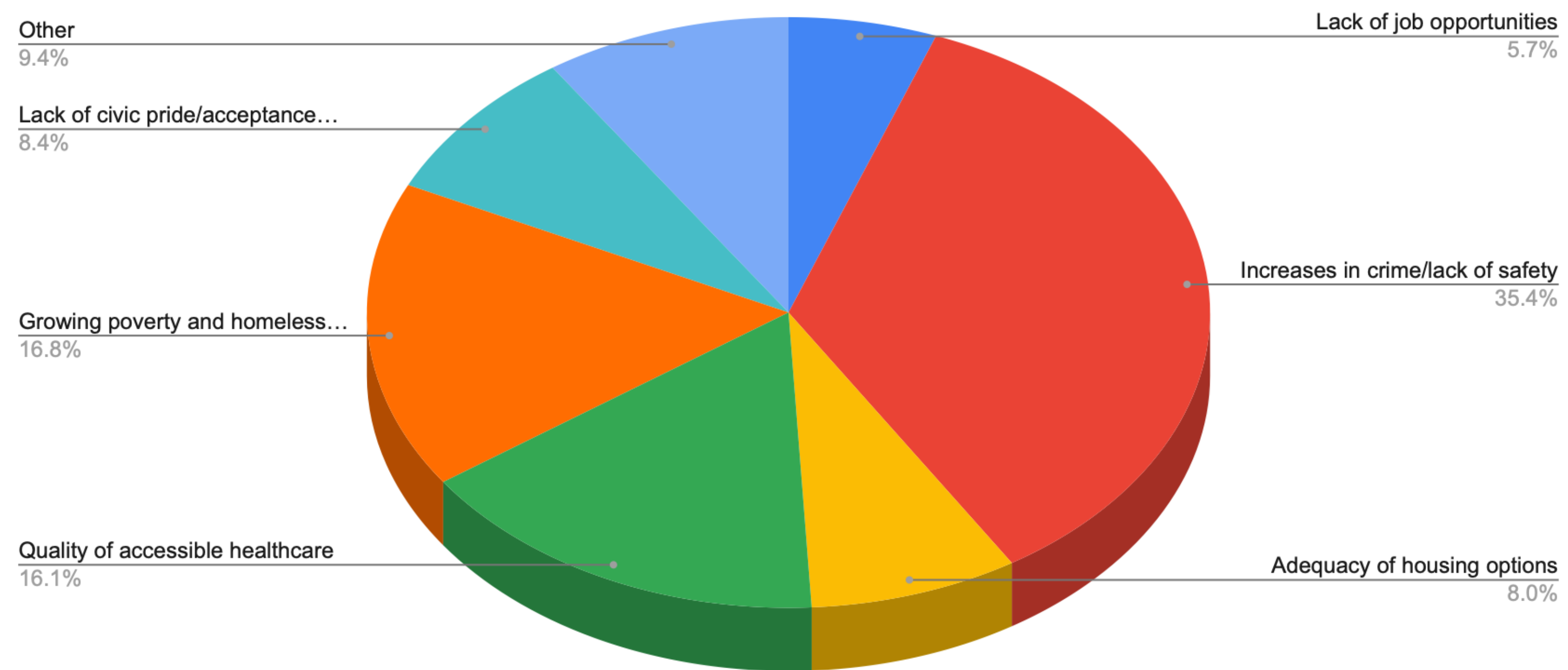


Question 3:
Where do you see the most opportunity to grow and benefit New Mexico?

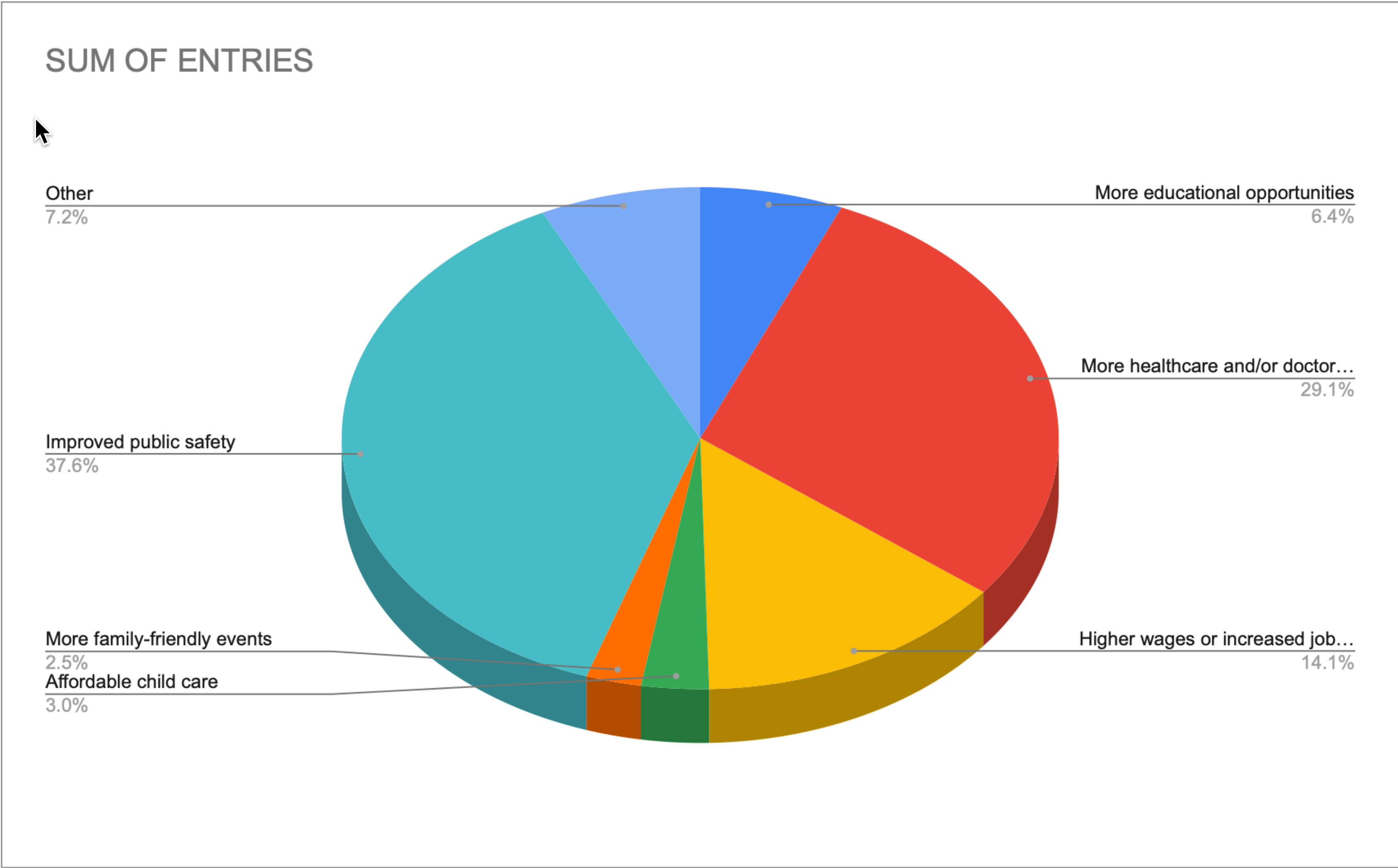


Question 4:

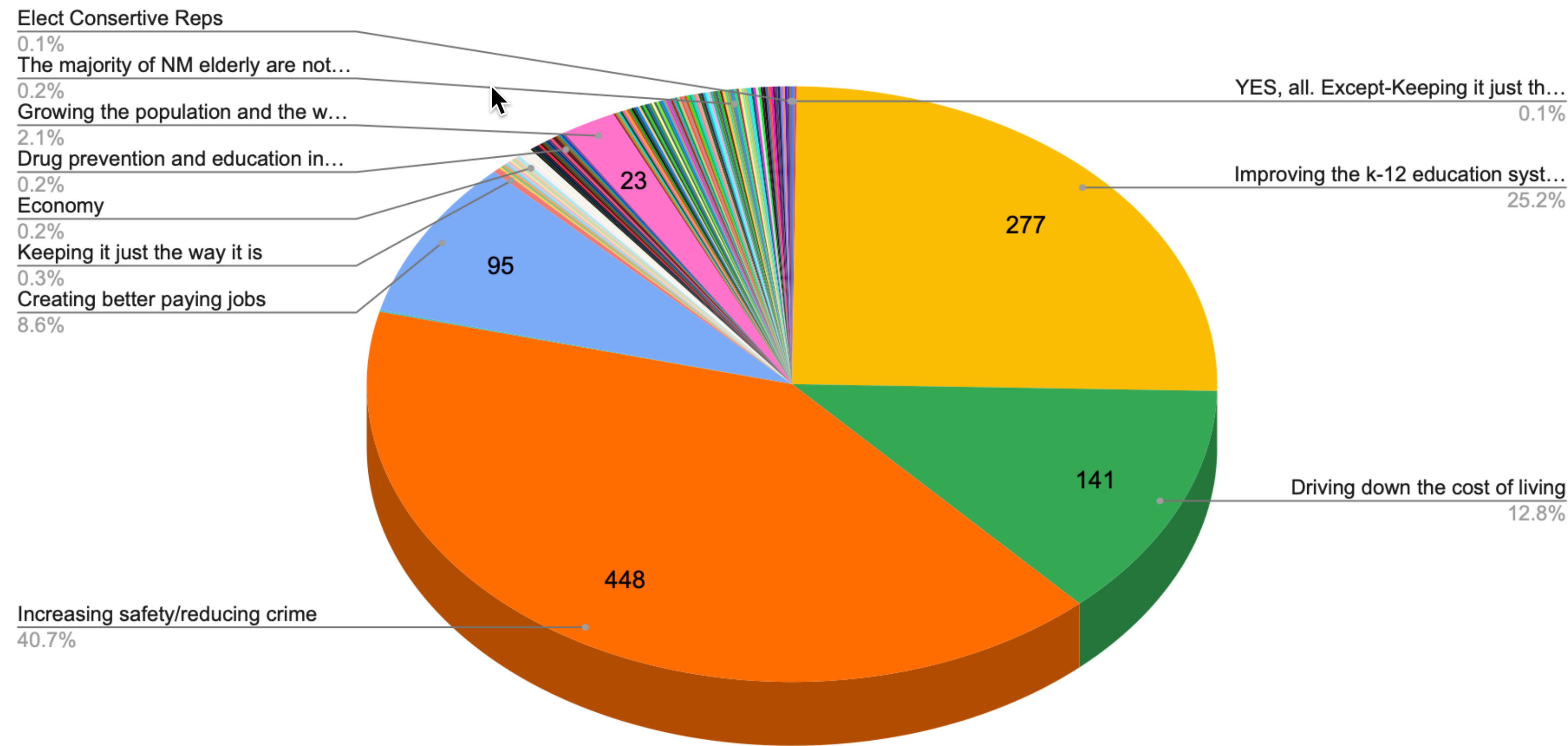


Question 5:
What form of assistance would you and your family find most helpful?

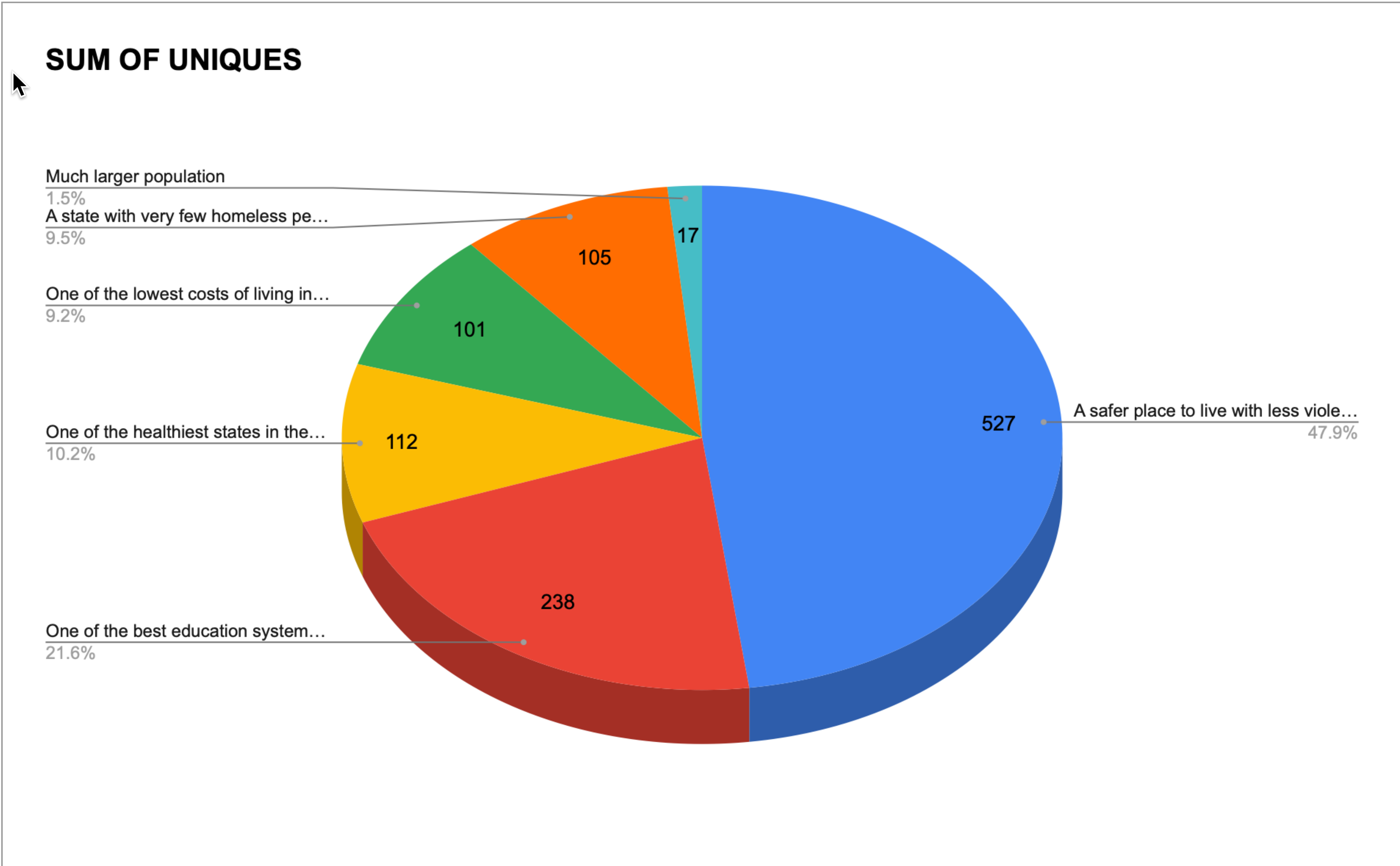

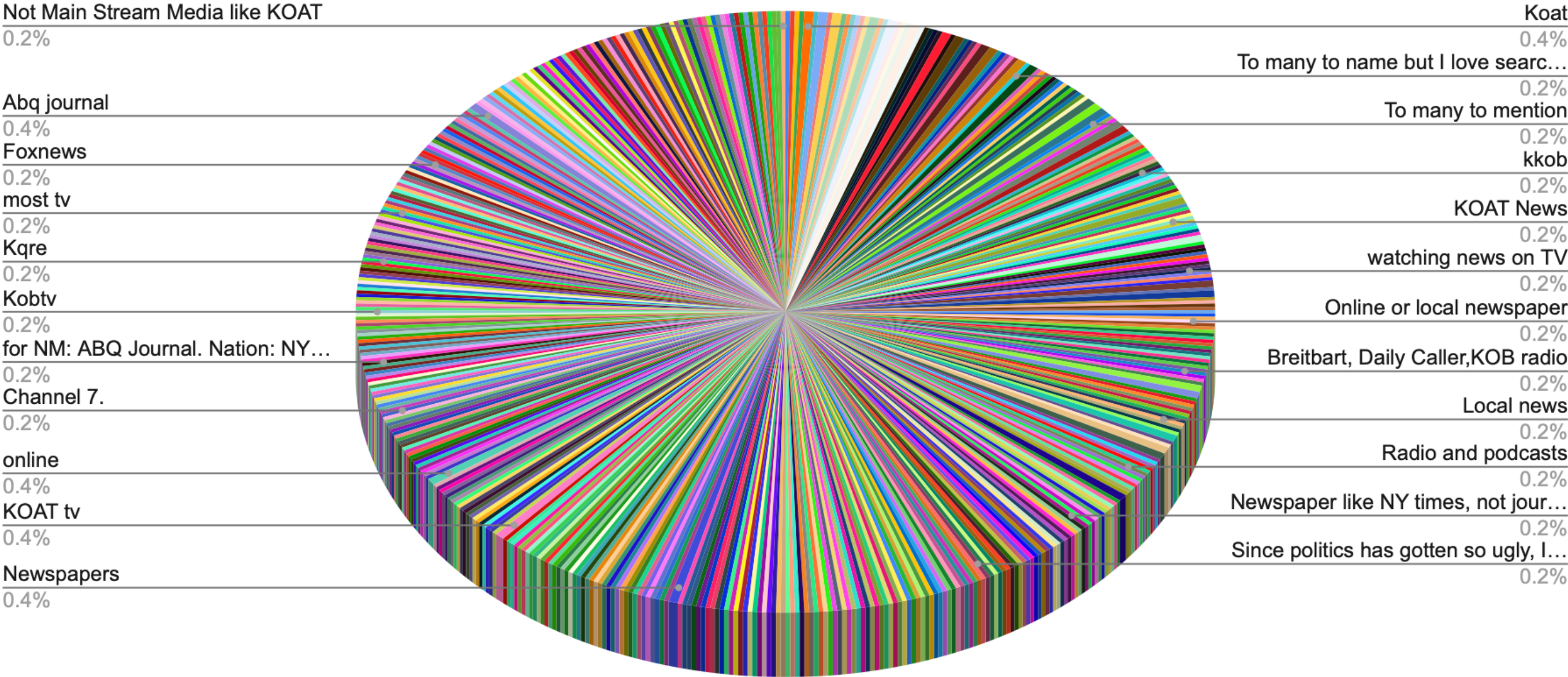

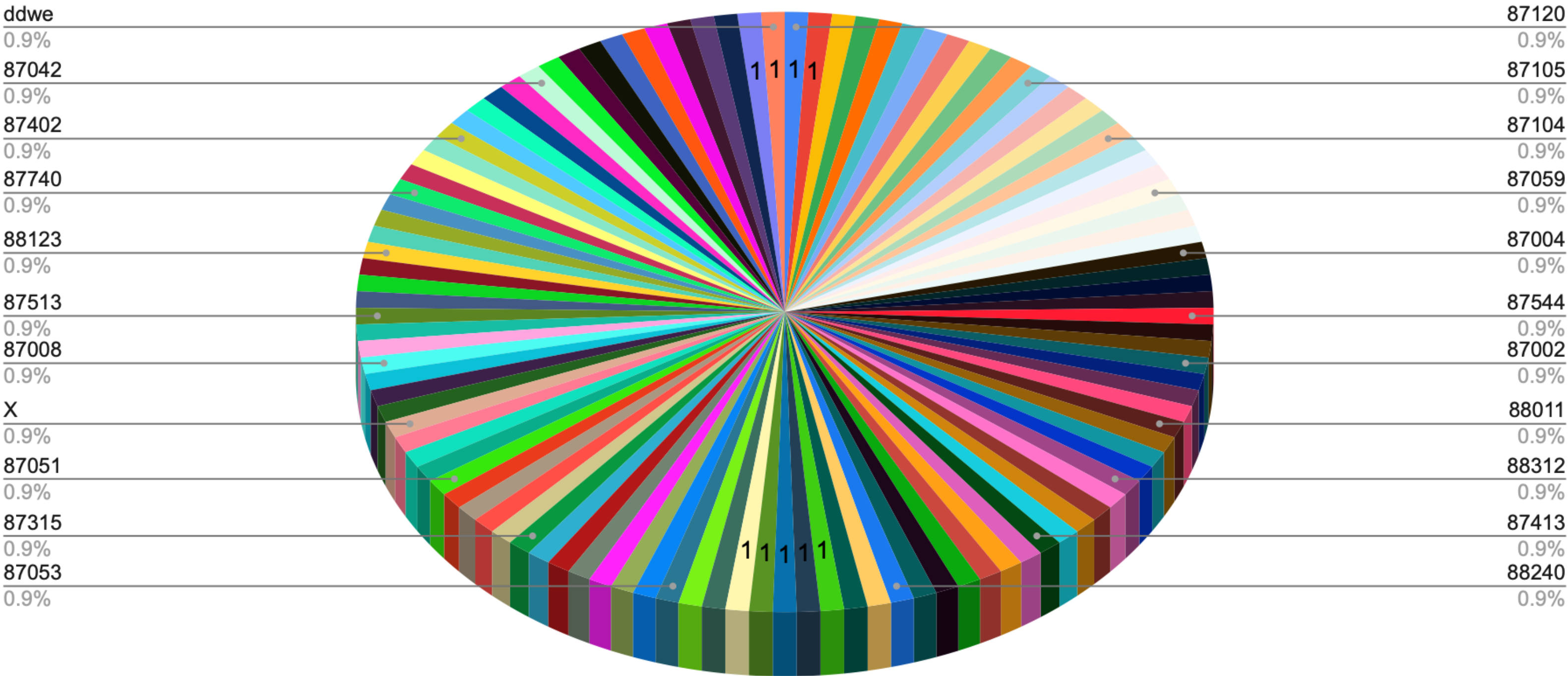

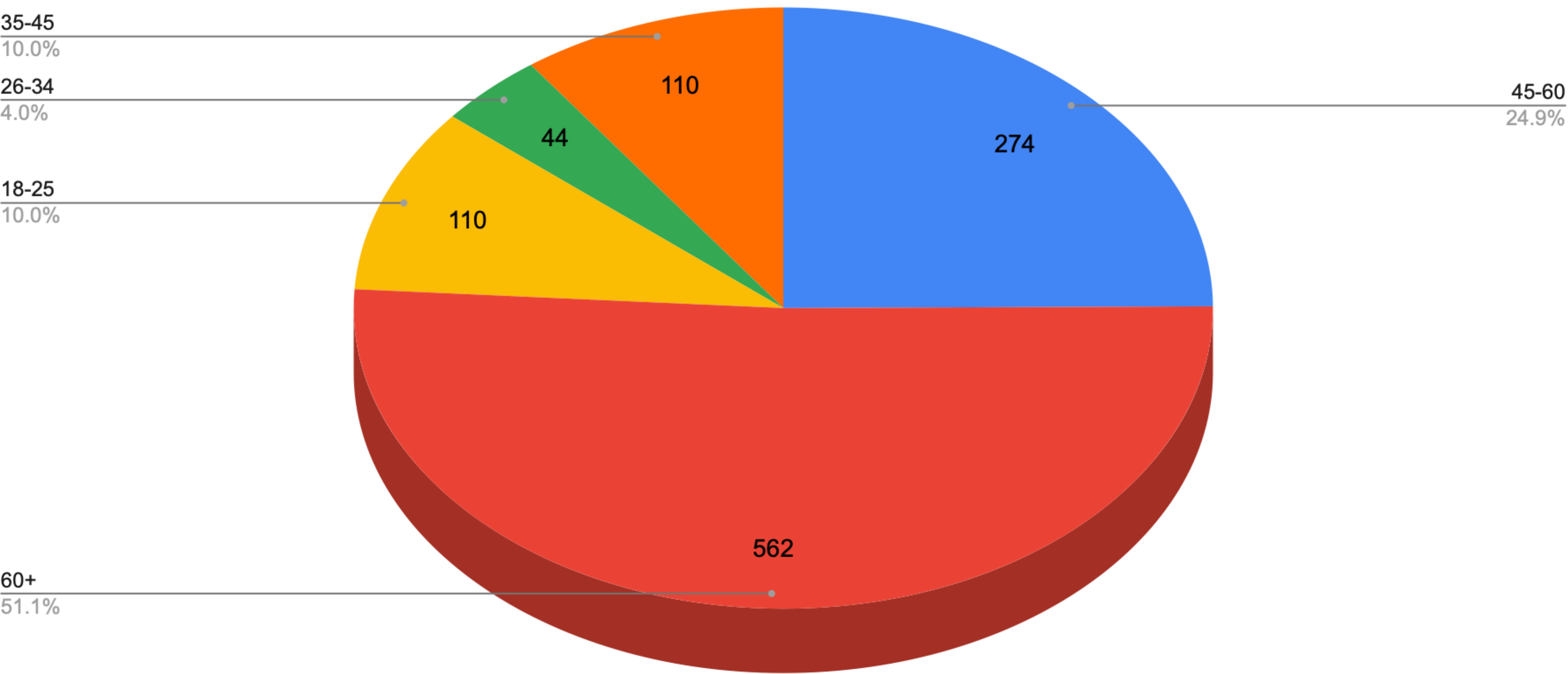

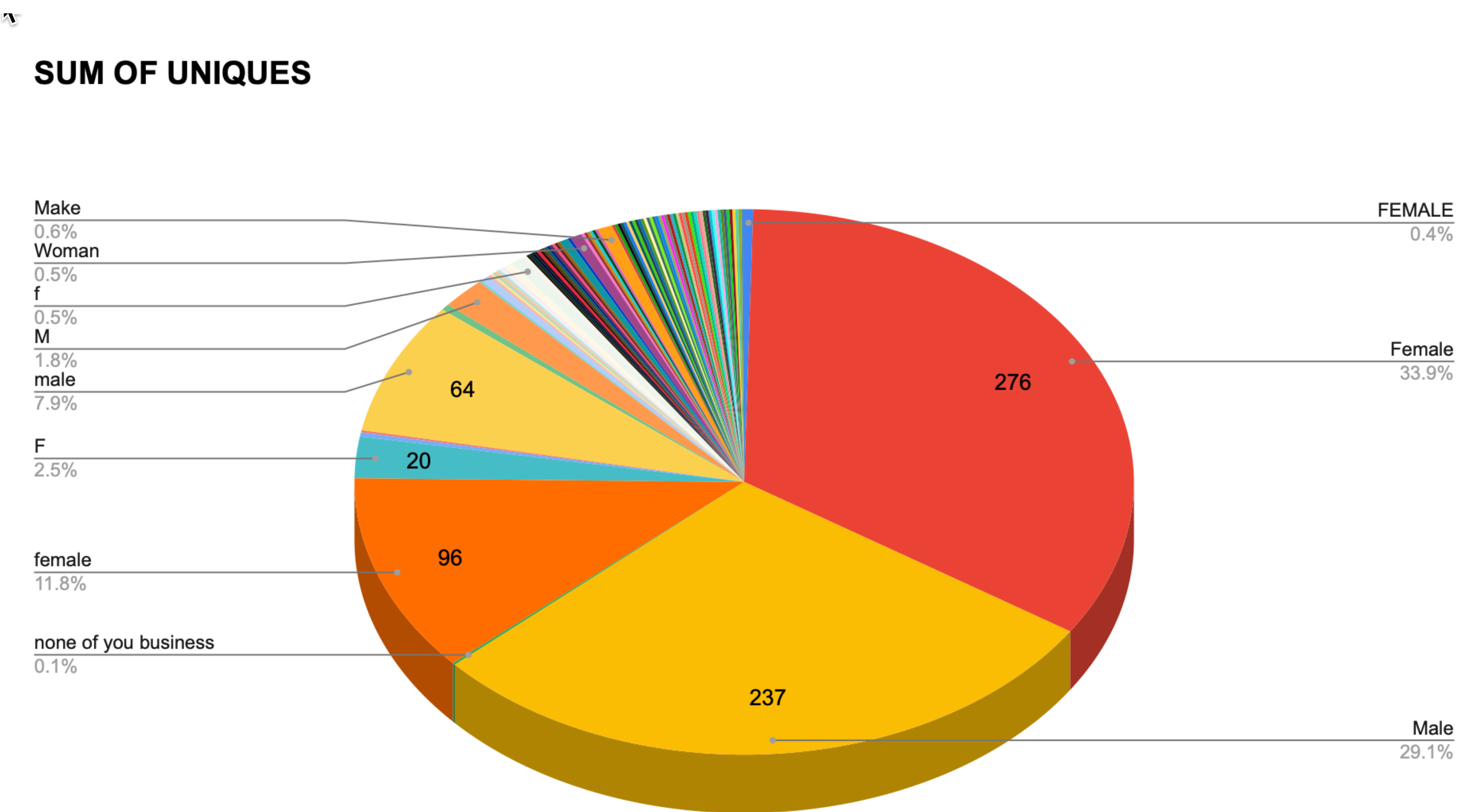
