SYNOPSIS

On February 17, 2024 at 1012 hours I responded to the area of Central Ave NE and Palomas Dr NE in regards to a shooting.

NARRATIVE

On February 17, 2024 at 1012 hours I responded to the area of Central Ave NE and Palomas Dr NE in regards to a shooting. Upon my arrival I met with Officer M. Lara who stated that an unknown offender(s) shot a firearm at or towards a person.

The incident occurred in front of Tewa Lodge located at 5715 Central Ave NE. Tewa lodge was a single story motel that was on the north side of Central Ave NE. I located a casing (c-1) on the west bound lane of traffic just south of the lodge and west of Palomas Dr NE. The casing was from a 9mm. I checked the area and did not locate any impacts or projectiles on any nearby buildings.

I took overall, mid-range photographs of the area to include the casing with and without indicators. I uploaded 20 photographs into evidence.com. I tagged the casing into evidence. No further items of evidentiary value were collected.

SYNOPSIS

On February 17 at approximately 0916 hours I was dispatched as back up assistance to Police Chief H. Medina who advised dispatch over the radio that he was involved in a vehicle accident and there was shots fired. The incident was documented and sent to GVSU Detectives.

NARRATIVE

On February 17 at approximately 0916 hours I was dispatched as back up assistance to Police Chief H. Medina who advised dispatch over the radio that he was involved in a vehicle accident and there was shots fired. Chief Medina reported that he was at the intersection of Alvarado St and Central Ave.

While on the way to the listed intersection Chief Medina reported that there was a white male armed with a gun that had ran into the Tewa Lodge but his exact location was unknown. When I arrived myself and other Officers cleared the courtyard of the Tewa Lodge located at 5715 Central Ave NE. I then assisted in traffic control and maintaining view of the Tewa Lodge as the possible Offender could still be in the area.

I then spoke with Chief Medina who told me that he was at intersection of Alvarado and Central just east of the Tewa Lodge when he noticed a white male and a black male begin arguing. Chief stated that during the argument the white male pulled out a firearm and pointed it at the black male firing a round at him. Chief Medina reported that he could see the barrel of the gun and knew he was in the line of fire so he immediately began driving and crashed at the intersection while attempting to get out of the line of fire. Please refer to case #240013749 for the crash report and details.

Officers were able to locate a single casing located on the north side of Central near the south east corner of the Tewa Lodge. Crime Scene Specialist (CSS) A. Montoya arrived and collected the casing and processed the scene.

Digital Image Video Recovery Team (DIVRT) also arrived and they collected video evidence from the Tewa Lodge. I did observe what appeared to be a male wearing dark clothing fire a gun towards the east and then run west on central passing the Tewa Lodge.

Officers then went to Envios El Rey business located at 5701 Central Ave NE and spoke with Edgar Munoz who told Officers that he had Cameras facing Central Ave. I observed the same male shooter running west and into a white pickup truck that was parked at the Café De Lat restaurant.

The truck appeared to be a lifted white Nissan Frontier early 2000's model with an off road tires, lift and black rims. The truck also had a black front push bumper.

DIVRT was able to retrieve multiple videos from the Tewa Lodge, Envios El Rey and Café De lat. CSS Montoya searched the area for a bullet impact but was unable to locate any. It should be noted that the victim of the aggravated assault did not stay on scene and did not contact law enforcement other than a short conversation with Chief Medina to tell him he was not shot.

A copy of this report will be sent to the GSVU Detectives for a follow up. Charges will be pending any further leads on the identity of the victim and the Offender. My OBRD was activated and all videos were uploaded to evidence.com.

SYNOPSIS

Surveillance Video Retrieval

NARRATIVEFebruary 7th, 2023

At about 0956 hours, the Digital Image and Video Retrieval Team (DIVRT) received a phone call from Lieutenant Andrew Jaramillo with the Investigative Support Section. Lt. Jaramillo advised for DIVRT to assist with obtaining videos with the case. The incident involved an unknown offender on foot shooting a firearm with negligence that also resulted in a traffic accident at the intersection of Central Avenue and Alvarado Drive in Albuquerque, NM 87108. The incident occurred on the morning of February 7th, 2023 at about 0916 hours.

At 1023 hours, DIVRT made contact with an employee at Kap's Coffee Shop & Diner located at 5801 Central Ave NE #1701, Albuquerque, NM 87108. The employee stated that there were no surveillance cameras located on property.

At 1024 hours, DIVRT made contact with the employees at the O'Rielly Auto Parts located at 5820 Central Ave SE, Albuquerque, NM 87108. The employee stated that they have one camera located at the back of the business that does not overlook the intersection.

At about 1027 hours, DIVRT made contact with an employee at the Trujillo Family Funeral Home located at 110 Alvarado Dr SE, Albuquerque, NM 87108. The employee stated he did not have access to the cameras and did not know if the incident was captured on their surveillance system. The employee stated that the owner has access to the cameras and will be in on Monday (02/19/2024).

DIVRT canvassed the area for cameras south of the intersection, but did not locate any that pointed towards the incident.

At 1037 hours, DIVRT made contact with the owner of the Tewa Lodge located at 5715 Central Ave NE, Albuquerque, NM 87108. The owner allowed for DIVRT to export video from their surveillance system. A total of ten video files were exported from Tewa Lodge's surveillance system. Video exported was dated for February 17th, 2024 with a timeframe of 0845 to 0930 hours. It should be noted that surveillance system is off by a few minutes and shows the incident occurred at about 0851 hours.

At about 1107 hours, DIVRT made contact with an employee at the Envious El Rey business located at 5701 Central Ave NE, Albuquerque, NM 87108. The employee allowed for DIVRT to export video from their surveillance system. A total of 302 files were exported from the surveillance system with a timeframe of 0730 to 0930 hours, dated for February 17th, 2023.

At 1139 hours, DIVRT spoke with an employee at the Cafe De Lat business. The employee allowed for DIVRT to export video from their surveillance system. DIVRT exported four videos from the surveillance system with a timeframe of 0844 to 1024 hours, dated for February 17th, 2024. It should be noted that time for this particular surveillance system is off and the incident occurred at approximately 1021 hours.

The video files from the Tewa Lodge were not compatible with standard media players. Therefore, at 1203 hours, DIVRT returned to Tewa Lodge and exported the video files in a different format.

Pictures of the offender and the offender's vehicle were taken from the videos collected by DIVRT.

All video and pictures from the video were uploaded to Axon.
